In addition to the noise, I have experienced numerous instances of fireworks being set off within the beer garden. I've also had people throw their glasses over the fence without provocation.

I have spoken in person with Bill Desing, one of the co-owners, several times and have also sent him numerous text messages about the noise issue. While he responds promptly and speaks positively, neither he nor the other owners have taken any actionable steps to address the noise. DESING stated that a former employee identified as Phillip PFEILSTICKER W/M DOB 01/15/1991 was seen on camera stealing approximately \$100 in US currency from the Bar. DESING stated that this incident occurred on 03/22/2025 at around 10:45 pm. DESING stated that the safe where they had stored US currency had been broken and that the US currency was being hidden under the safe in a box. DESING stated that since the beginning of the month he has started noticing that the money that was being store was not balancing out with daily transactions. DESING stated that he decided to install cameras inside of the room.

DESING stated that the night of 03/22/2025 PFEILSTICKER was inside of the bar and was not on the clock as an employee but was a customer. DESING stated that he observed PFEILSTICKER go inside the room which is locked and requires a code to unlock. DESING stated that he observed PFEILSTICKER on camera retrieve money from under the safe and put the money on his left pocket.

DESING showed me the video recording of the theft; I observed a white male wearing a blue flannel and blue jeans. I observed the subject retrieve what appeared to be money from under the safe and put it in his left pant pocket. DESING was then seen going back to the bar. DESING stated that there was \$100 in US currency missing.

DESING stated that PFEILSTICKER has been an employee for about 3 months and works part time and doesn't have a set schedule. DESING stated that after the incident he texted PFEILSTICKER on 3/23/2025 at 5:07 pm and confronted him about him taking the money and told him that he will not press charged if he returns the money. PFEILSTICKER stated to him that he would return the money. DESING stated that it has been a couple of days and PFEILSTICKER never returned the money.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 2/18/2026 at 1:40 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.


