



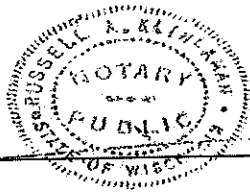

Substitute resolution approving levying of assessments and construction of assessable public improvement projects at various locations and appropriating funds for these purposes with the City cost of these projects approved by this resolution is estimated to be \$6,108,952.02 for a total estimated cost of \$13,517,077.02.

Whereas, The Common Council of the City of Milwaukee adopted preliminary resolutions, determining it necessary and in the public interest to construct and levy special assessments for the following improvements:

**3rd Aldermanic District**

N. Humboldt Blvd. - E. North Ave. to E. Keefe Ave. (ST3201606XX) (2667-03-71) File Number 151714: Concrete pavement reconstruction, replacing curb and gutter, sidewalk, driveway approaches, storm sewer, traffic signals and street lighting. This project is anticipated to be constructed in the 2022 construction season.

Grantor Non-Reimbursable Paving Fund - \$5,008,695.65

Grantor Reimbursable Paving Fund - \$751,304.35

City Share Non Assessable Paving Fund - \$4,767,282.02

City Share Assessable Paving Fund - \$75,000

These funds are to be transferred to the construction account (ST3201606XX) (2667-03-71)

Street Lighting Funded in ST240220418-\$872,350.00

that the Commissioner of Public Works' Report, as amended at said Public Hearing, is approved and the properties therein identified are benefited; and, be it

Further Resolved, That said Commissioner of Public Works is authorized and directed to proceed with said work in accordance with said report pursuant to Section 66.0703 and any other pertinent sections of the Wisconsin Statutes and in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the proper departments take such action as is required of them to assess the abutting or adjacent properties and collect such assessment in the manner directed by Section 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer such funds which are available for this purpose to the appropriate capital Project/Grant accounts; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the projects do not involve any parcels of agricultural land which are eligible for deferred special assessments under the provisions of Section 14.30 of the Milwaukee City Charter; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the Department of Public Works is authorized to use the funding as specified in the above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the project will be billed after January 1, 2024, but not before 12 months after the project contract has been completed; and, be it

Further Resolved, That the project is to be set up using 2022 budget funds, if surplus 2021 funds are available, some or all of the project may be funded with 2021 funds.
