The MPD initiated a criminal investigation in which the officers initially declined to give a statement without counsel. When they requested counsel, IAD compelled POs McDermott and Martinez to give statements concerning the incident after issuing PI-21s. Later, the MPD did not bring criminal charges against the officers. Attached is a copy of the clearance report and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

- I, Detective HARRISON attempted to contact some neighbors at 10615 West Calumet Road, howeve I was unable to interview any parties at that residence.
- I, Detective HARRISON then proceeded to District Four Police Station to find out who was working the night of September 02, 2002, with a white male and a white female partner. I, Detective HARRISON did find a HIT sheet (PD-10), which included a white female and white male, Police Officer Dena MARTINEZ, payrol number 69432 and Police Officer Patrick MCDERMOTT, payroll number 64026.
- I, Detective HARRISON and Detective William C. SMITH attempted to speak with Police Officer Patrick MCDERMOTT, payroll number 64026, date of appointment 06-08-96, who is currently assigned to District Four early shift. This interview took place at the Police Training Bureau, located at 6680 North Teutonia Avenue, third floor, interview room. At this time, Officer MCDERMOTT was advised that this is a criminal investigation of a Theft complaint, however he himself was not the focus in said investigation. Officer MCDERMOTT was further advised of the circumstances surrounding this matter, at which time he requested union representation/lawyer and preferred not to make a statement at this time. Sergeant Kurt DREZEK then issued Police Officer Patrick MCDERMOTT a PI-21.

. We also spoke with Officer Dena MARTINEZ, payroll number 69432, date of appointment 11-26-02, currently assigned to District Four, early shift, and she is currently on probation. Officer MARTINEZ was advised that this is a criminal investigation of a Theft complaint, and she may or may not be the focus in said investigation.

After advising Officer MARTINEZ of the circumstances surrounding this matter, she at this time requested a lawyer or union representation and did not want to make a statement. Sergeant Kurt DREZEK then issued Police Officer MARTINEZ a PI-21 regarding this incident.

After speaking with Police Officer MATOS, who advised me that he did not want to prosecute regarding this incident, I also spoke with Commander Steven M. SETTINGSGAARD who also advised me that Sheriff David CLARKE also did not want to prosecute regarding this incident. This incident will be cleared as "No Prosecution Desired."
