		The actual Reinspection Fee revenue in 2015 under the current fee schedule (\$60-\$75-\$200-\$350) was \$7.5 million. The current 2017 revenue estimate under the current fee schedule is \$3.2 million. If the proposed \$100-\$200 fee schedule is approved, the 2017 revenue estimate should increase to \$5.53 million, a \$2.33 million increase from the current 2017 estimate.
