

which allegations shall be taken as true. If the Committee determines that the allegations are sufficient, the law requires that the license shall be revoked or suspended.

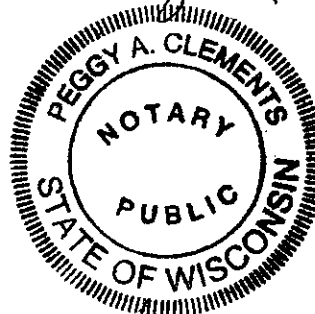
