The above-referenced charter ordinance implements pension benefit changes included in five collective bargaining agreements: the 2004-2006 agreement between the City and the Milwaukee Police Association, Local #21, I.U.P.A., AFL-CIO, the 2003-2004 and 2004-2007 agreements between the City and the Milwaukee Building and Construction Trades Council and the 2003 and 2004-2006 agreement between the City and Local 75, Journeyman Plumbers' and Gasfitters' Union, AFL.CIO.

Costs associated with this ordinance were reported on the fiscal notes attached to Common Council Files No. 021160, 031029 and 021162.
