

contained the money was thrown out at the Criminal Justice Facility before the Criminal Investigation Unit could retrieve it. The plastic envelope was checked for fingerprints with negative results.

Detectives interviewed all of the officers working at District Three on the dates in question, as well as the personnel from the Prisoner Processing Section who conveyed Pao XIONG to the Criminal Justice Facility. Detectives also interviewed the sheriff deputies who received Pao XIONG'S property at the Criminal Justice Facility. None of the persons interviewed had any knowledge of the missing money.

### **CONCLUSION:**

Investigation by the Criminal Investigation Unit revealed that Pao XIONG was arrested and conveyed to District Three. At District Three, XIONG'S property was inventoried which included \$21.55. When XIONG got to the Criminal Justice Facility it was found that \$20.00 was now missing from his property. All of the personnel who had contact with Pao XIONG'S property, as well as all personnel working at District Three during the times in question were interviewed. No one admitted having any knowledge of the missing money. This case will be suspended pending further information.
