1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The grant will perform tree planting and pruning, as well as limited hazardous tree removal and replacements on owner-occupied private property within Milwaukee's most disadvantaged census tracts. The work will be conducted through program participation that is directed through Forestry Services' equity-based, data model. Program participants will be empowered by choosing the work to be performed on their property from a menu of options.

Community-Based Organizations (CBO) will engage, elicit participation from, and educate communities on the program and urban tree planting and maintenance.

Private contractors will be procured to perform the prescribed work.

The Forestry Services' website will be redesigned to elicit program participation and provide robust community engagement and education around the urban tree canopy.
