There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. This report was written by Police Officer Dorian WHITTENBERGER, assigned to District Three - Early Power Shift, Community Prosecution Unit. On November 11, 2020, I was assigned to Squad 3271, and

rode in a tan unmarked Ford Crown Victoria (#803) along with Squad 3272 (PO Demetrious HUDSON) and Squad 3264 (PO Michael JONES).

On Wednesday, November 11, 2020 at approximately 4:03, we conducted a site visit of the location. The location was observed to be open and operating with people walking in and out. While conducting the site visit and license premise check, the store was temporarily shut down for safety concerns. We conducted the site visit, because while across the street at a community event, we observed a lot of suspicious activity, loiterers, subjects walking in and out then standing outside, and subjects walking to vehicles then back to the stairs of the business.

When inside the store, it was confirmed the subjects have valid licenses. No subjects on scene has a bartenders license, but two of the subjects on scene are blood related to the owner and live under the same roof. One subject, identified as Oday ISSA (m/w, 7/20/99), was upset during the inspection. Mr. Oday continued to say that the police need to do their part in the issues around the business and start patrolling. I informed Mr. Oday that proper signage would help allow officers to enforce loitering, but that there were no signs. Once Mr. Oday calmed down, a constructive conversation was able to be had. Another worker and family member on scene was Abdallah ISSA (m/w, 7/16/98). Mr. Abdallah just sat behind the glass and would agree with Mr. Oday, but not argue. There was a subject that was stocking, Kiontae D. JONES (m/b, 05/23/94). Mr. JONES would argue with officers on scene and stated that there is issues, but that they should not have to call the police and police should do their job.

The owner, Ala ISSA (m/w, 4/2/97) was not on scene and did not answer the phone. I had a conversation with MR. ISSA on a later date. He apologized for his staff and stated that he would talk to them. Mr. ISSA stated that he would add signage and agreed that he would start to call police regarding illegal activity. Mr. ISSA stated he does see a huge problem with crack cocaine being sold in the area, but he is afraid for his safety if he were to say something.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 7/13/2021 at 11:50 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
