This is in response to a request we received from Northwestern Mutual on behalf of their 777 North Van Buren Street property to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that motorists exiting the properties driveway on North Jackson Street have a difficult time seeing traffic traveling southbound on North Jackson Street when vehicles park close to the driveway. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing this restriction to increase sight visibility.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.
