

**REASON FOR REQUEST:**

Michael Hamann, a City of Milwaukee Police Officer, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was traveling southbound on North 35<sup>th</sup> Street with its emergency lights and siren activated. As the City vehicle approached West Vine Street, the uninsured motorist, who was also traveling southbound on North 35<sup>th</sup> Street, failed to yield the right of way and turned left into the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Hamann sustained injuries to his neck and upper back. The treating physician has indicated the injury is permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$79,099.26.
