There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with<br/>warrants or unpaid fines:Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the<br/>above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the<br/>granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

- On 09/26/21 at 2:20am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue for a fight compliant. Investigation revealed that a group of subjects tried to fight a single subject outside the tavern. The one subject handed security a firearm and all subjects began to fight (including security). The security guard who was handed the firearm, began striking subjects with that firearm. The applicant was on scene and was involved in the fight.
- 2. On 10/06/21 at 2:00pm, a subject walked into the Second District to report a battery which occurred on 10/01/21 at 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue. Investigation revealed that the subject was drinking at the tavern and got into an argument with two subjects. The argument turned physical and all subjects were removed by security. While outside the subject was assaulted by several people which required him to seek medical attention.

3. On 05/15/22, officers and detectives responded to a shooting at 1913 W. Lincoln Avenue. Investigation revealed that the victim had patronized the tavern located at 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue and left the establishment at closing time. While sitting in his vehicle, a subject fired over forty rounds into his car killing him.

4. On 06/10/22 at 9:45pm, Milwaukee Police, along with the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, conducted a license premise check at 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue. When entering the tavern

police observed two security guards who were armed (one had a firearm in his pants pocket and the other in a satchel). The applicant was upset with the Department of Revenue Agent and said he was going to call his cousin and complaint to her about the "tavern check". The applicant did not have any receipts for the liquor brought for the tavern but said he had them at his residence. The agent gave the applicant a chance to produce the receipts on a later date and confiscated all the liquor that was left by the previous owner.

- 5. On 06/11/22 at 1:03am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue for a noise complaint. Upon arrival, Officers observed that the tavern was closing and patrons were gathered outside playing loud music from their vehicles and loitering in front of the tavern. Police did not observe any security guards trying to get patrons to leave or stop playing their loud music. Officers interviewed the caller who stated that this is an ongoing problem.
- 6. On 06/12/22 at 1:38am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue for a ShotSpotter compliant. Investigation revealed that a subject was denied access to the tavern because he had a firearm. The subject became upset and a small altercation happened out front with security and the subject. A short time later the applicant heard multiple shots fired. Officers recovered 16 spent casings, with 3 rounds striking the address of 1834 W. Lincoln Avenue.
- 7. On 07/13/22 at 4:00pm, Milwaukee Police, along with other representatives of the city, conducted a meeting with the applicant from 1900 W. Lincoln Avenue. The reason for the meeting was to explain to the applicant that his premise was going to be designed a chronic nuisance property and the options or actions he can take. 19 calls for service were entered into the report.
- 8. On 08/21/22 at 2:03am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1900 W Lincoln Avenue for a noise compliant. Upon arrival, the tavern was closed and there was only one person outside. Officers interviewed the manager who stated that she has been trying to control the people who go outside and plans to hire another security guard to help with the noise. She also said that she has an issue with the caller because he walks by the tavern when she's opening with a firearm on his hip and calls her a derogatory name. Officers tried to explain the report process to the caller but he hung up on police.

9. On 03/25/23 at 1:10a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at a local hospital. It was determined the incident occurred at 1900 W. Lincoln Av. The victim stated while at the bar, the agent grabbed them by the arm, causing pain and injury. The officer did observe bruising to the arm. The officer attempted to contact the agent, however, there was no answer at the residence or via telephone.

10. On 02/11/24 at 1:50a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 1900 W. Lincoln Av. Officers interviewed a security guard on scene who stated they had to remove two intoxicated patrons, however, other than escorting them out, there was no physical contact. The agent was unable to operate the cameras; therefore, officers were unable to review the incident.


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# City Concentration Map 1900 W LINCOLN AV

Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

# Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.


