
**RE: Resolution relating to the Temporary Historic Designation of the Milwaukee Journal Company Building at 333 West State Street in the 4th Ald. District.**

Dear Journal Sentinel, Inc.:

This letter is to inform you that the above matter was approved at the Historic Preservation Commission meeting of March 4, 2019 as the building meets the criteria of s. 320-21-3-e-1, e-3, e-5, and e-9, Milw. Code of Ordinances. Section e-1 relates to its exemplification and development of the cultural, economic, social or historic heritage of the city, state of Wisconsin or the United States. Section e-3 relates to a building's identification with a person or persons who significantly contributed to the culture and development of the city. Section e-5 relates to a building's embodiment of distinguishing characteristics of an architectural type or specimen and section e-9 relates to a building's unique location which represents an established or familiar visual feature of a neighborhood, community or the city.

The hearing for the permanent designation is scheduled for March 18<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 in City Hall, Room 301-A. I have enclosed a copy of the study report that was done by staff.
