Summer Youth Internship Program February 2005 Progress Report Community and Economic Development Committee File No. 041367

At the direction of Mayor Barrett and the Common Council, the Department of City Development (DCD) is coordinating a new City of Milwaukee Summer Youth Internship Program.

Key Elements

- Allocation of \$350,000 in CDBG funds for program development and implementation.
- Program designed by a working group including representatives from the Mayor's Office, Department of Employee Relations, CDBG, Housing Authority, Milwaukee Public Schools, Milwaukee Public Library and Department of City Development.
- Hired a program coordinator through a partnership with UWM's Milwaukee Idea Economic Development Fellows Program to develop and operate the Summer Youth Employment and Workforce Development Program.
- Contacted City departments to identify departmental program coordinators and begin development of youth internship positions.

Goals

- Create 200-250 city employment opportunities for 16-19 year old high school students.
 - o Jobs are expected to begin June 20, 2005 and end July 29, 2005.
 - o Internships will be paid equally.
 - o 6-week placement, 20 hours per week.
 - o Improve workforce preparedness among participating students.
- Create approximately 20 team leader positions for college students (age 21 and older) to supervise youth in city positions.
 - o 8-week placement, 30-hours per week.
 - o Leaders will be paid equally.
 - o Monitor progress of interns.
 - o Ensure faithful attendance.
 - o Accountability.

Application materials have been posted (both online and paper) in the UWM Career Development Center, Marquette University Career Services Center, MSOE Placement Office and MATC Student Employment Services Center.

- Create Workforce Development component to teach the interns general life skills through weekly 4-hour workshops on resume writing, appropriate workplace behavior, dress, work readiness skills, etc.
- Develop a community action plan to connect qualified high school interns with private employers that provide after-school jobs during the school year.

Student Recruitment

- Outreach to high school youth through Milwaukee Public Schools.
- Outreach to team leader candidates through area colleges.
