### Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie A. Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Shannon Cannestra and Michael Anderson. The claim is in the amount of \$726.00 for 6.60 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by the filing of a citizen complaint against the officers with the Fire and Police Commission. The complaint was dismissed by the Commission.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat § 895.35, Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Dear Mr. Leonhardt:

The above-named police officers have retained us to represent them in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent them and as they were performing the duties of their office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on their behalf for the indicated legal fees.

Mr. Hopkins was arrested on or about June 13, 2002, and gave a false name to officers. Hopkins filed a citizen complaint with the Fire and Police Commission (FPC) on July 26, 2002. When the FPC attempted to schedule a conciliation, the complainant informed the FPC that he would be incarcerated for the next 13 months, and was therefore unavailable for the conciliation. The FPC dismissed the complaint due to the complainant's unavailability.

Hopkins also apparently still has criminal charges pending as a result of the incident in which he was arrested on June 13, 2002, as well as other charges in Waukesha county for operating a vehicle without the owner's consent, and theft of movable property without the owner's consent.

0119/04 0.tr Juse 2 effer 2291 You have indicated on other matters that you have some concerns where a complaint has been dismissed without prejudice. However, as we have noted in our prior discussions, the City should not penalize the officers for Mr. Hopkins' incarceration.
