1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**

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





To Whom It May Concern:

This is a complaint against MKE Cab license # 140.

My husband and I rode from the MKE airport to our home at . . . I can't say specifically what time we got into the cab, but we were driven directly home, and I had to call 911 at 9:25pm, so I would say we started the ride at approx 9:00pm.

As we entered the cab my husband specifically asked the driver, "you take credit cards, right?", and the driver replied, "oh, yes, yes!". All is well and good until we arrived at our destination. We handed the driver our card as there was NO terminal installed in the cab. He took our card, then reached over to the passenger side of the cab and exclaimed, "OH NO! I left my phone at home, it has the thing, I don't have a way of taking the credit card!". (what cab driver leaves his phone at home!?!)

We reminded the driver that we specifically asked, about accepting credit card payment, and he specifically said he did. Then he said, "wait, wait, I'll see if I can do it another way". Then proceeded to fumble around with a huge pile of papers on the passenger side floor, as if looking for a paper/swipe set-up. Naturally he was not able to produce that either. I said, "why don't you call your dispatcher and I can give them the card # and they can process it over the phone". That's when he said, "what dispatcher, it's just me." I went to grab the credit card back from him and he refused to let go, yelling "hey, hey, hey!!!". I told him if he didn't give us the card back that I would

call the police. He said, "fine - call them, go ahead, call them". That's when I dialed 911. In the mean time, my husband offered him \$20 to let us out of the cab and give us our bag back. He refused saying he can write down the card number and run the card "later".

I got a 911 operator on the line and described our problem with the cab driver to her as quickly as possible - she could barely hear me (and visa versa) as the driver was screaming so loudly at that point. I was actually beginning to fear for our safety. I told her that we had agreed on a credit card transaction and that basically we were now being held against our will, by a cab driver that was holding our credit card against our will! I think once the cabbie realized that I actually was on the phone with the police, he agreed to take the \$20 and get rid of us, so he could get out of there before the police actually arrived.

The only identification in the entire cab that I could find was the cab # 140 (a silver mini-van with red lettering). I never asked him his name, nor would he have given it to me I'm certain. I could identify him in a photo though. Their certainly was no "Non-cash Payment Passenger Usage Guide" posted anywhere in the cab or I wouldn't have needed to hunt and peck online to find it buried here on the City of Milwaukee website!

I've never even come close to filing a complaint like this before, but I've heard cabbie horror stories from others (especially women traveling alone). Enough is enough. What if we had been out of town visitors? What sort of impression would that have been? I'm embarrassed just thinking about it.

Please follow-up with me so that I know this complaint has been heard, and what, if anything will be done in handling it.

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

I'd like to file a complaint against Cab 715 whom I took a ride from in the early hours of 5/2/2015

The driver was unwilling to use the most efficient route (I-94), and instead tried to use a "secret" route despite the pleas of her GPS system, which she routinely ignored for the entire trip, and led us on a completely inefficient route, which included train tracks which she leisurely sat at for at least 5 minutes (with the meter running, of course). A driver's personal preference for travel (avoiding interstates due to "potentially unsafe" driving conditions) should not outweigh the demands of the customer to arrive at their destination in the most efficient manner. For what it's worth, when we were finally able to direct our driver as to the correct route which involved the interstate - our driver decided to drive I-94 West at an average speed of 35 MPH, which I'm sure we can both agree is terribly unsafe for anyone involved.

So, instead of what is normally a \$14-17 cab ride from downtown Milwaukee to our address (316 S 69th St), our driver decided to take us on a scenic tour of Bay View and the South Side, resulting in a cab fare of \$30 - more than double our usual expectation to arrange a ride home, which has normally been done in the most efficient manner by other Yellow Cab drivers. Customers such as myself should not be expected to subsidize the whims of a driver unfamiliar with the greater Milwaukee area.

I know it's unlikely that any type of restitution is possible, but I simply wanted to make Yellow Cab aware, to prevent other customers from paying for impromptu Milwaukee tours at 2am.

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

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Public Works and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Public Works will take place on 10/19/2016 at 9:30 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Public Works makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

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## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Public Works to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**
