1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The Wisconsin Department of Health Services (DHS) receives funding from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) via a Water Infrastructure Improvements for the Nation (WIIN) grant to fund water outlet testing in licensed group childcare centers and Head Start facilities. Currently, the City of Milwaukee has 521 of these childcare facilities, 158 of which are considered priority childcare facilities by DHS. Priority facilities include all Early Head Start facilities and any Head Start facility serving children under the age of 3. Confirmatory water testing will result in water fixture replacement.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

City wide goals and department objectives are accomplished via water testing for lead at water outlets within all priority licensed child care facilities within the City of Milwaukee. Childcare facility water testing will also occur concurrently with city goal of providing lead abatement to qualifying child daycares and the ability for childcare facilities to apply for a voluntary lead safe registry post abatement.

3. Need for Grant Funds and Impact on Other Departmental Operations (Applies only to Programs):

No impact to other Departmental operations. Grant funds will be used to provide water testing to qualified licensed child care facilities and to pilot a lead safe registry within these facilities.

Progress reporting will occur monthly and include enrollment levels, facility water testing results, and plumbing fixture replacements

Grant Period October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025. End of project and funding will not reduce MHD overall capacity.
