5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

I plan to restore the missing wood architectural elements on the exterior of the home including columns, brackets and sashes. All replacement parts will be crafted from clear cedar.

I plan to restore the front entrance doors or if they are in too poor condition locate replacements of the correct age, appearance and thickness using the existing parts as templates. The doors will have at least 1/3 glass panes.

I plan to restore all existing original windows to the extent practical. I will replace all modern replacement windows with wood windows, probably using the Jeldwen brand. Existing inoperable windows on the turret will remain inoperable. The larger window in the turret will be replaced with a inoperable window replicating the appearance of the East window. I will look for a piece of art glass for the missing circle at the head of the turret.

It will replicate the trim of the South dormer for the East dormer and replace the South dormer window to replicate that of the East dormer. The sides of both dormers will be trimmed with square cedar shake as will the rear dormer.

'Missing decorative wood on the second story wood decorative pattern would be replaced.

I will replace the Bilco door with a newer version.

The East/side porch is missing a colonette that will be replicated. The door will be replaced with a period appropriate exterior door and the transom will be cleaned. The pipe railings will be painted and left intact until future porch restoration can be completed with a separate approved COA project.

The rear porch will be replaced with a simple wood structure mimicking the front porch. The porch deck and stairs will replicate the width of the roof (approximately 5 x 5 foot.)

The exposed rafter details show missing secondary flanges on about 3/4's of the home. I would replicate these from clear cedar and install them where missing.

The West facade remains painted. If and when the view of the home becomes apparent from the street will have the paint removed by a qualified professional using chemical rather than sandblasting.





ADD WINDOWS DOOR




SIDE PORCH DETAIL


