This is to notify you that on Tuesday, May 15, 2018, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council revocation of the Cigarette and Tobacco license(s) for the premises located at 3520 W Villard Ave. ("Villard Ave Groceries & More") based on the sworn complaint, and police and aldermanic testimony.

On May 18, 2018, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the revocation of the Cigarette and Tobacco license(s) in which the Committee recommended that the license be revoked based on the sworn complaint, and police and aldermanic testimony. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Wednesday, May 30, 2018, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to revoke the Cigarette and Tobacco license(s) based on the sworn complaint, and police and aldermanic testimony. Said revocation begins May 30, 2018.
