1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

To participate in US EPA Great Lakes 2008 Earth Day Challenge by hosting a one-day household electronics collection event at the Italian Community Center South Parking Lot located at 631 E. Chicago Street on April 26, 2008. This electronics collection event will offer a one-time opportunity for City of Milwaukee residents to dispose of old televisions for recycling. This grant is the result of an invitation by the US EPA to participate in the Great Lakes 2008 Earth Day Challenge. The City did not have to compete for this funding, but rather was awarded based on past results and experience.

2. Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

The City accepts computers and computer peripherals for recycling at the two self-help centers located at 3879 W. Lincoln Avenue and 6660 N. Industrial Road. The proper recycling of household electronics reduces the amount of waste disposed of in landfills, recovers valuable materials for re-use such as gold, silver, copper, plastic, glass and steel and reduces the environmental costs of raw material extraction and processing.
