

Dear Ms. Bailey:

We have received your claim in the amount of \$792.00, relating to damage to your parked vehicle on August 5, 2011 when you allege that paint and gravel were thrown onto it when the City painted the lines in the street at/near 6th and Cherry.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate that on August 5, 2011 a DPW Street Maintenance Crew was sawing concrete at the corner of North 6th Street and West Cherry Street. As a result, some water mixed with dust was sprayed onto your vehicle. The crew indicated that at no time did any stones hit your vehicle. As such, the City would not be liable for the claimed repairs. Therefore, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
