Alderman,

I have been working with Clark and Jeff on this issue.

I have attached a chart showing the number and percentage of local streets and alleys that have been approved at the assessable public hearing from 1999-2005. Note that there aren't any deletions for sidewalk repair program because the public hearing isn't required. Each year the number of projects varies due to the length and scope of the individual projects.

As with the number of projects proposed, the amount of engineering expended also varies—for the 2005 program, it was nearly \$400,000. As you know, when a project is deleted, we typically bring it back in 5 years. For the second time, the amount of engineering typically is less, the project is just updated and costs are evaluated, so this original engineering time isn't wasted.

I am not aware of us having a way of measuring the long term impact on the quality of streets and alleys with this deletion rate. Once a project is deleted, our maintenance to the facility is minimal. Obviously, each year costs keep going up both to the property owners and to the city as a whole.

As you may know, I am proposing a vehicle registration fee whose proceeds would be used to offset the assessable portion of local street, alley and sidewalk improvements. The \$20 annual fee would generate about \$7M. The precise allocation of these funds has not yet been determined, but one idea is to completely replace the assessable portion of street improvements and part of the assessable cost of alley and sidewalk improvements.
