..Analysis

This ordinance establishes that, with the license period beginning December 1, 2009, no new public passenger vehicle permits for taxicabs shall be issued for or shall be transferred to any motor vehicles not meeting a minimum city rating of 25 miles per gallon as estimated by the United States environmental protection agency. With the license period beginning December 1, 2011, no new public passenger permits for taxicabs shall be issued for or shall be transferred to any motor vehicles not meeting a minimum city rating of 30 miles per gallon as estimated by the United States environmental protection agency. ..Body

The Mayor and Common Council of the City of Milwaukee do ordain as follows:

Part 1. Section 100-50-3-d and e of the code is created to read:

100-50. Public Passenger Vehicle Permits.

3. ELIGIBILITY.

- d. In addition to the age of vehicle restriction established under par. c, with the license period beginning December 1, 2009, no new public passenger permits for taxicabs shall be issued for any motor vehicles not meeting a minimum city rating of 25 miles per gallon as estimated by the United States environmental protection agency, as amended.
- e. In addition to the age of vehicle restriction established under par. c, with the license period beginning December 1, 2011, no new public passenger permits for taxicabs shall be issued for any motor vehicles not meeting a minimum city rating of 30 miles per gallon as estimated by the United States environmental protection agency, as amended.

Part 2. Section 100-50-12-e-3 and 4 of the code is created to read:

12. REGULATIONS.

e-3. In addition to the age of vehicle restriction established under subd. 2, with the license period beginning December 1, 2009, no public passenger permits for

taxicabs shall be transferred to any motor vehicles not meeting a minimum city rating of 25 miles per gallon as estimated by the United States environmental protection agency, as amended.

e-4. In addition to the age of vehicle restriction established under subd. 2, with the license period beginning December 1, 2011, no public passenger permits for taxicabs shall be transferred to any motor vehicles not meeting a minimum city rating of 30 miles per gallon as estimated by the United States environmental protection agency, as amended. ..LRB
