This subcontract from CHS will support "care coordination" for children hospitalized due to the severity of their asthma. Care Coordination entails reviewing families for eligibility, educating them about services to be provided, obtaining informed consent and referring enrolled families to a case management provider. The goal of care coordination and case management is to improve the quality of life for families impacted by asthma through assessing their needs, developing a family—centered plan of care and making appropriate referrals for services. The Health Department's Care Coordinator will also interface with case management providers to assure a standardized intervention for evaluation purposes.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

Pediatric asthma is a strategic priority under the Health Department's Home Environmental Health and Maternal and Child Health Divisions.
