HEALTH DEPARTMENT 2011 Salaries & Wages 2011 Operating Expenditures	\$230,000	\$230,000	This request is driven primarily by expenses for temporary services or contract positions, which were needed to perform functions that otherwise would have been left undone due to a high number of vacancies during 2011. Major program impacts affected by these expenses included the STD clinic, technology services, and administrative support. In addition, property services at the clinics were higher than budgeted due to snow removal costs and the need for higher than expected translation services. It should be noted the department reallocated approximately \$100,000 of its budget to meet other higher than expected expenses. This transfer will still allow for a significant lapse of unexpended wages/salaries funds to the Tax Stabilization Fund.
