- 1. Gable vent needs to be larger with a longer vertical axis.
- 2. Eliminate porkchop eave returns. Use traditional open return or eliminate return.

All work must be done in a craftsman-like manner, and must be completed within one year of the date this certificate was issued. Staff must approve any changes or additions to this certificate before work begins. Work that is not completed in accordance with this certificate may be subject to correction orders or citations.
