

This is to notify you that on Wednesday, September 7, 2016, the City's Public Works Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renewal, with a ten (10) day suspension, your application for a Taxicab Permit license based on based on your testimony substantiating the citizen complaint.

On September 9, 2016, you were mailed true and correct copies of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Public Works Committee with respect to the renewal application for a Taxicab Permit license, in which the Committee recommended that the license be renewed with a 10 day suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, September 20, 2016, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear and you did not file written objections to the report of the Public Works Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Public Works Committee, the Common Council adopted the recommendation of the Public Works Committee to renew with a ten (10) day suspension the Taxicab Permit license based on your testimony substantiating the citizen complaint. Said suspension is effective from September 20, 2016 through 11:59 p.m. on September 29, 2016.
