1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):

The Milwaukee and North Shore Speed Enforcement Task Force, which includes MPD, the Village of Whitefish Bay Police Department, the City of Glendale Police Department, and the Village of Shorewood Police Department, was created with the intent of bringing together a multi-jurisdictional Traffic Safety Task Force geared towards a High Visibility Enforcement (HVE) effort focused on decreasing traffic crashes and obtaining voluntary compliance with traffic regulations.

2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:

It is the mission of the department to decrease fatalities, serious injuries, and long term disabilities as a result of reckless driving and driving negligence, and, to increase overall public safety.
