File #051246 is a resolution authorizing and directing a transfer of funds from the Capital Improvements-Advance Planning Fund to two subaccounts for the preparation of the northeast side, near north side and near south side area plans in Aldermanic districts 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, and 15 as well as for economic studies and special engineering and technical studies.

## **Background and Discussion**

- 1. The Advance Planning Fund is used to finance planning studies and research into land use, marketing, development, and redevelopment proposals.
- 2. Currently, to utilize the unencumbered Advance Planning Fund balances, the department must obtain authorization to transfer the funds to a sub account via a Council resolution.
- 3. The Department of City Development needs funds to hire consultants on an asneeded basis.
- 4. According to the department, consultants are needed to assist staff by providing technical assistance and studying housing, commercial and residential development and land use for land use policy development planning activities.

## **Fiscal Impact**

This file authorizes a \$140,000 transfer and expenditure from the 2006 Advanced Planning Fund.
