The Health Department is submitting the following grant resolution for Common Council approval

Refugee Health Screening Grant - This continuation funding from the State of Wisconsin Division of Economic Support aids the City of Milwaukee's Tuberculosis Control Clinic in providing outreach, screening and other public health services to refugees. Changes to the positions ordinance are incorporated in the resolution.

<u>Tobacco Control Grant</u> - Funded by the State of Wisconsin Division of Health and Family Services, the grant award includes funding for the Wisconsin WINS Program and the Milwaukee Community Tobacco Coalition. The funding will continue the goals of the broad-based community tobacco coalition in order to achieve a strategic community plan to eliminate tobacco-related health disparities and the morbidity and mortality associated with tobacco use.
