My Supervisory District 10 includes the north side of Locust Street from I-43 to 13<sup>th</sup> Street and the entirety of Locust Street from 20<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> Street.

I fully support the MICA Holy Ground Core Team at Hephatha Lutheran Church in their request for re-installation of the traffic signal at 17<sup>th</sup> and Locust as soon as possible. I agree with them that the signal is needed to protect pedestrians, especially children, in that vicinity who need to cross Locust Street, a thoroughfare that is often treated by drivers as a raceway. An additional safety concern is the hazard to people attending Hephatha, loading and unloading on Locust.

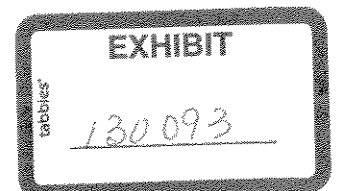
I request that the City take the prudent step of re-installing the signal at 17<sup>th</sup> and Locust to protect its citizens, young and old.

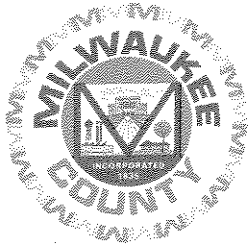
