**Regarding:** Your Class A Fermented and Food Dealer Licenses Renewal Application as agent for "CENTER STREET FOODS LLC" for "CENTER STREET FOODS" at 4630 W CENTER St.

There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the licenses if objectors provide testimony related to the factors enumerated in MCO 85-4-4 that the Common Council finds to be true by a preponderance of the evidence and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

**Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:**

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

Center St. The clerk denied the sale but was the only clerk in the store. The applicant was mailed a MARTS letter.

5. The applicant did register for MART regarding Item #4 but failed a mystery shopper and was issued a citation for the original incident.

Center St. The clerk was identified as Mohammad ALTARAWI and he admitted the sale but could not state why he did not ask for ID. The applicant was mailed a MARTS enrollment letter.
8. On 10/01/2018 officers were dispatched to Center Street Market, 4630 W. Center St, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. When the officers arrived they saw a customer arguing with and employee. They interviewed the employee who stated the customer pulled a knife on him, threatened him and other employees. The customer was arrested for Disorderly Conduct.

The applicant allowed officers to check the business and they found no evidence of the violations.

11. On 04/18/21 at 6:11pm, officers were dispatched to a Shooting at N. 47<sup>th</sup> and W. Center St. Officers conducted a canvas of the area and found Center Street Market, 4630 W. Center St., had surveillance cameras that captured the incident. The employee was cooperative and provided officers with video footage.

12. On 12/16/23 at 1:06p.m., Milwaukee Police were assigned to work Wisconsin WINS, which checks area vendors for age compliant tobacco sales. A youth entered 4630 W Center St., and did purchase tobacco products from the cashier, who was also the agent. The agent apologized for the sale.

13. On 12/17/23 at 5:54p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shotspotter at 4630 W Center St. On arrival officers recovered 7 .40 caliber casings on the ground in the parking lot. Investigation revealed the victim was in the store talking to the cashier, when the suspect removed a firearm from the victim's pocket and fled on foot. The victim gave chase, at which time the suspect fired rounds into the air. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.

On Saturday, 06-07-25 I, Officer LAUX, was working with Denise Pitchford who is a coordinator with the Wisconsin WINNS Tobacco Prevention Program. We worked with a 16 year old male and a 16 year old female. Both of them had a WI Id Card that indicated they were 16 years old. The juvenile male or juvenile female would walk into a location together and one of them would attempt to purchase tobacco products. If the store employee asked for their WI ID Card, they would present the store employee with their WI ID Card. If the store employee did not ask for a WI ID Card, the juvenile male or juvenile female would not present the store employee with their WI ID Card. The legal age to purchase tobacco is 21YOA in the State of Wisconsin.

On Saturday, 06-07-25 at 12:55 PM a 16 year old juvenile with the initials MHH B/M 05-18-09 walked into a store called Center Street Market Address: 4630 W Center St., located in the city and county of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. A Cashier identified as Issa Z. El NATOUR W/M 03-23-67 Address: 4626 W. Center St. Phone: 334-7156 sold him a Black and Mild Cigar containing tobacco. El NATOUR never asked to see his WI ID Card. When I spoke to El NATOUR he completely denied that he failed to ask him for his WI ID Card. He stated he checks everyone's ID Card.

Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

## Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.  
**Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.**
