- 1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):
 - The Milwaukee Police Department (MPD) is the fiscal agent for a multi-jurisdictional traffic safety task force comprised of MPD, Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office, and University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee Police Department focused on decreasing traffic crashes and obtaining voluntary compliance with traffic regulations to decrease fatalities and serious injury collisions. This grant will fund a campaign targeting seat belt enforcement. MPD will conduct enforcement activities in high traffic areas to improve compliance of motor vehicle occupant restraint laws and encourage use of seat belts.
- Relationship to City-Wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:
 Improved safety on city roadways is a priority for the Milwaukee Police Department and is a focus of the Traffic Safety Unit. TSU utilizes traffic safety approaches designed to create deterrence and change unlawful traffic behaviors.

 - The total grant award of \$61,200 with a grantor funded amount of \$48,960 (80%) and a local inkind match of \$12,240 (20%) will fund Police Officer overtime for deployments during enforcement periods from October 2024 -September 2025. The award breakdown includes MPD at \$28,960 MCSO at \$15,000 and UWM at \$5,000.
