On July 30, 2021 the workers who picked up my recycling trash slammed the hydraulic unit into my recycle container and severely damaged my overhead garage door. Per the enclosed photos you can plainly see that the damage lines up with the plastic recycle container against the door. They dented the outside door and separated the inside plastic from the insulation which can not be repaired. This door is no longer manufactured and replacement parts are obsolete.

Because the impact of the recycle cart hit the garage door so hard it triggered my alarm which loudly goes off inside and outside my house and garage.

I went downstairs first to check the alarm and it told me the problem was in the garage. I then went outside to see what was going on and I saw the recycle vehicle and men about 2 houses down the alley from mine. I yelled and waved to get their attention and they totally ignored me and did not stop. There was no way they didn't realize what they did and the alarm should have certainly alerted them that there was an issue.

I notified Alerman Murphy what had happened and emailed him pictures of the damage. I then contacted my insurance company and also received two estimates. He emailed me the instructions for filing a claim against the City of Milwaukee.

Photos, two estimates and a copy of my insurance check is enclosed. A new door has to be ordered and the lead time is quite long. It will not be installed until this Spring. A new door will cost \$2,760.00. My insurance company issued me a check for \$1828.54. I think it is only fair for the City of Milwaukee to pay the balance of \$931.46. I would appreciate a fairly quick response.. Thank you for your attention in this matter.
