Dear Council Members:

We return the enclosed document which has been filed with the City Clerk and ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary Legislation with the following recommendation.

Claimant, Beverly Werdin, 5620 West Valley Forge Drive, Milwaukee, WI 53213 alleges that sometime in late February 2004 she sustained damages when the sewer and water contractor for her new home, being constructed at this address was unable to locate the lateral connection to the City's main sanitary sewer. She claims damages in the amount of \$14,054.00.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division indicates that representatives of Atkins Construction contacted them on several occasions to request information regarding the existence of a sanitary sewer service to the property. Initially, they provided information verbally over the telephone. The contractor was having difficulty locating the service. The division faxed a copy of the sewer plat page to the contractor. Subsequently, the division's staff did further research to check the locations as depicted on the sewer plat page and the information indicates that a service was installed in the general area, but no dimensioned location is shown on the plans. After receipt of this claim, they conducted a field investigation and found that the
