If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. I called the complainant. He said was going to go back to the store and get more details about specific products. I gave him my e-mail address so he can send that info to me.

We talked about the provisions of the price gouging law (Wis. Admin Code s. ATCP 106). Basically, it's not necessarily illegal for a store to have a high price on an item – but it is illegal for a store to raise prices on items if the state is in an emergency due to an abnormal economic disruption.

This report was written by P.O. Bowie Buchner, assigned to district seven, early power shift.

On Tuesday August 31, 2021 I was instructed to file a license premise report regarding this incident. Upon reading the report it stated that a suspect attempted to rob a security guard for Dee's Elegance.

The security guard was armed and the suspect was shot during the attempted robbery. A separate license premise report was filled for Dee's Elegance. The location used in the report was the Express Gas Pantry located at 7405 W Villard Av. A check revealed that location as a Filling Station License (FILL 1616), a Food Dealer License (FOOD 12049), a Cigarette and Tobacco License (CIG 1030171), and a Weights & Measures License (W&M 6643).

On Sunday, August 29, 2021, at approximately 11:03 PM, PO Jason DAERING and P.O. Nicholas SCHLEI, Squad 4281, were dispatched to a Shots Fired complaint in the area of 7300 W Herbert Avenue. They spoke with the caller, "Rita", who indicated she heard multiple gunshots from what she believed were at least two different firearms. She stated the shots sounded like they came from the southwest of her residence.

They saturated the area and observed multiple casings in the roadway in the approximate 7400 block of W Fond Du Lac Avenue. This is in close proximity to Dee's Elegance bar at 7420 W Villard Avenue and the Citgo gas station at 7405 W Villard Avenue.

While checking the scene for casings and any vehicles or buildings struck by gunfire they heard a male yelling "Get down on the ground!" and "Keep your hands up!". They observed a male on the north sidewalk of W Grantosa Avenue, just west of W Fond Du Lac Avenue, who waved them over. The male was holding an AR-15 style rifle and did place it on the ground as they walked over, stating that he was robbed by the boy on the ground. The officers asked the male if he was armed security from "Dee's" and he stated that he was.

They observed a black male juvenile lying prone on the sidewalk. He was bleeding from his lower back area and his pants were saturated with blood. They would observe an apparent gun shout wound to his right lower back area. As they were checking the male he stated "I have a gun on me." They frisked his waistband area and observed the grip of a handgun that was concealed in his front waistband area. They recovered the handgun from his waistband and observed it was clear of any ammunition. There was a magazine inserted that was empty. The safety was "off" and the exposed hammer was cocked back.

PO DAERING and P.O. SCHLEI would stand by with the male that flagged them down and stated he was robbed. The male was identified as Lewis L. GAMBLE (B/M 02-12-1983). They would convey him to District 4 for processing, then to Central Booking to be interviewed

During the investigation it was determined that this incident occurred after GAMBLE was the victim of an armed robbery that took place at Express Gas, located at 7405 W Villard Av. GAMBLE had gone to the gas station to obtain change for the bar.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 06/28/2022 at 10:05 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
