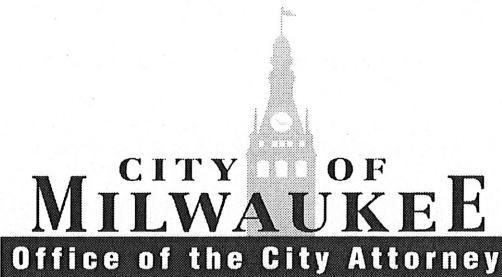

Enclosed please find a proposed resolution. We ask that it be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation, with the following recommendation.

WE Energies alleges that the City damaged their manhole while excavating at East Cass Street and Wisconsin Avenue. These damages occurred on or about November 10, 2015.

The Infrastructure Services Division/Electrical Services completed their investigation in this matter and found that while excavating, they hit the WE Energies manhole with their equipment.

Because settlement of this matter is deemed expeditious to the City of Milwaukee, we recommend settlement of this claim in the amount of \$15,000.00 and have enclosed an appropriate resolution for your convenience.
