
Dear Mr. Johns:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, June 18, 2019, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council to renew with a ten (10) day suspension the Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises, Food Dealer, and Sidewalk Dining licenses for the premises located at 1103 N Old World Third St ("The Pub Club") based on the police report and applicant and aldermanic testimony.

On June 7, 2019, you were mailed a true and correct copy of the findings of fact, conclusions of law, and recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to the Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises, Food Dealer, and Sidewalk Dining licenses in which the Committee recommended that the licenses be renewed with a ten (10) day suspension based on the police report, and applicant and aldermanic testimony. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of Tuesday, June 18, 2019, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in the Common Council Chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of the right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time, and place, you did not appear, and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee. You were not represented by counsel.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council voted to renew with a ten (10) day suspension the Class B Tavern, Public Entertainment Premises, Food Dealer, and Sidewalk Dining licenses based on the police report and applicant and aldermanic testimony. Said suspension is in effect between 12:01 a.m. on July 7, 2019 until 11:59 p.m. on July 16, 2019.


Dear Mr. Flowers:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, June 4, 2019, the Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the Common Council to deny your application for the Food Dealer license transfer application requesting a change of hours for the premises located at 4102 W Townsend St (“Kingdom Cooking”) based on nonappearance.

On Tuesday, June 18, 2019, the Common Council considered the Committee’s recommendation regarding your application. On that date, the Common Council adopted the Committee’s recommendation and denied the Food Dealer license transfer application with change of hours based on nonappearance.

If you previously paid the license fees you may be eligible for a refund, except for a portion of the fee that may be retained, by bringing in the receipt or filing an application for a refund within one year to date of Common Council action with the License Division, Room 105, City Hall.
