Re: Common Council File No. 020785

I enclose a petition executed on behalf of 525 Properties Limited Partnership protesting adoption of Common Council File No. 020785, a substitute ordinance relating to zoning regulations for existing television towers. If adopted, this file would allow the height of all towers used for television broadcasting on October 1, 2002 to be increased under certain circumstances without approval from the Board of Zoning Appeals or the Department of City Development. Most immediately, the file would permit Hearst-Argyle to extend its tower height to add antenna capacity without even investigating co-location opportunities on other existing towers, much less making "every reasonable effort" to co-locate as required under Milwaukee Code of Ordinances section 295-413.

The purpose of submitting the enclosed petition (as well as petitions submitted on September 20, 2002) is to require a three-fourths vote of the Common Council to approve File No. 020785, pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances section 295-307 (formerly 295-61-2). 525 Properties Limited Partnership owns the television tower located at 3950 North Holton Street. Together with the petitions from MATC and CBS 58 submitted on September 20, 2002, the enclosed petition brings to three the total number of towers objecting to the file. Objection by three out of the seven towers affected by the proposed ordinance constitutes objection by 42.29% of the affected property owners, which exceeds the 20% threshold required by section 295-307.
