Hello,

On Friday, October 9, 2015, I jumped in cab 490 a little after 6 pm to take a ride from the airport to the Psifler Hotel. I believe the driver's name was Mohammad. He asked me why I was in town and I told him that it was to see my boyfriend play basketball against the Bucks.

The standard cab ride from the airport to downtown should be no more than \$35. The driver continued to go in circles adding up their fare. I even pulled up the GPS on my phone and told him that he was going in circles. He told me that he knew what he was doing. I was intimidated by him after his tone of voice escalated when I told him that I saw the same landmark twice in the drive to the hotel. The cab drive added up to \$53. This was unheard of. He took advantage of me just because he assumed I had the funds to pay for it. He can't take advantage of a 22 year old female like that, be confrontational with.

When I got to the hotel, they made a complaint about the driver after seeing how much he charged me and told him that he is not allowed back there. But, I want to dispute the charge. I really need a refund back. At least a partial refund. I've been taken advantage of, treated poorly, and I'm disappointed.

Please let me know if you can help me.



I OBSERVED FIVER STAR TAXI #490 PARKED IN THE TAXI STAND AT THE HILTON HOTEL LOCATED AT 509 W WISCONSIN. I APPROACHED THE DRIVER AND INTRODUCED MYSELF AND REQUESTED TO SEE THE DRIVER'S PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLE LICENSE AS WELL AS DRIVER'S LICENSE, TO WHICH HE PROVIDED AND WAS IDENTIFIED AS MOHAMMAD F ALI A/M 12/01/58.

I THEN REQUESTED TO SEE THE DAILY SAFETY INSPECTION AND TRIP SHEETS. ALI OPENED A NOTEBOOK AND SHOWED IT TO ME, HOWEVER, THE LAST DOCUMENTATION WAS ON 03/18/15. I ADVISED ALI THIS NEEDS TO BE FILLED OUT DAILY AND ASKED FOR MORE RECENT RECORDS, TO WHICH HE COULD NOT PROVIDE AND STATED HE HAS BEEN SICK LATELY AND HASN'T WORKED. I ADVISED ALI THAT IT WAS HARD TO BELIEVE HE HAS NOT OPERATED THE CAB SINCE MARCH 18. I ASKED HOW LONG HE HAS BEEN DRIVING TAXI, TO WHICH HE REFUSED TO TELL ME HOW MANY YEARS, ONLY STATED "A VERY LONG TIME". I ADVISED ALI I WOULD BE ISSUING A CITATION AS HE IS WELL AWARE OF THE RULES FOR TAXI OPERATION IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKEE.

PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by PO Penny BROWN assigned to License Investigation Unit. On Friday, May 20, 2016, at approximately 11:00a.m., I was on patrol checking taxi cabs for compliance.

I observed Five Star Cab # 490 parked in the posted taxi stand at the Hyatt Hotel, located at 333 W. Kilbourn Ave. I introduced myself to the driver and requested to see his Public Passenger Vehicle License as well as Wisconsin Driver's License. The driver provided both to me and was identified as Mohammad F. ALI A/M 12/01/58. I then requested to see his Trip Record and Daily Safety Inspection. ALI stated that when the City inspected his vehicle he was told he no longer was required to keep these records. I advised ALI this was not true, he is still required to keep the written records for 90 days. ALI apologized and stated he would comply in the future.

I travel to Milwaukee from Chicago twice a month for work and have only good cab service here in Milwaukee until yesterday Sunday, 9/28/2014. After exiting the Amtrak train that arrived in Milwaukee at 9:34pm I went to the ATM machine and then proceeded outside to the line for cabs. The first cab that pulled around was a minivan with an middle eastern gentleman driving cab #237. I walked around and got in on the passenger side of the vehicle. I instructed the driver that I would like to go to the Fairfield Inn. The driver then acknowledge me and then asked a couple who was standing on the driver's side where were they going. The young lady answered and at this point he popped the rear door and told the couple to also get into the cab. The driver jumped out and proceeded to place their bags in the rear compartment. I then stated "Hold on I'm in the cab and there's no way that you can take both fares". The driver stated that "he can take up to 5 fares at one time". I stated that I have traveled to almost every city and state and have never heard of such a thing unless the riders make that plan but never the driver. My door was still opened because I was not going to pay full fare and allow this driver to take another fare from a honest cab driver out here who was obeying the rules, the cab driver hopped out of the driver's seat and came around to my door and asked if I was going to ride and if not to exit his vehicle. I exited the vehicle and immediately took a picture of his vehicle and called the dispatch service. Now after getting off the phone with dispatch I went to the back on the line to again wait on a taxi. At this time yellow taxi #269 pulled up, I walked around to the passenger side to get into the vehicle. As I reached for the door the driver says through the front passanger window "where are you going?". I stated "can I get into the cab first", as my hand literally touched the handle the driver rolled down the rear passanger window and stated again, "where are you going?". I leaned down to be on eye contact level with the driver and asked "Is there some new requirement that I must state where I'm going before I get into the cab?". The driver looked me dead in my eyes and said "YES!" He then pulled up to where another couple was standing, by the way which was not at the walkway where they generally pickup and asked them where they were going and proceeded to pick them up to transport them. I then also took a picture of his cab so that I can retain the cab number.

Thankfully cab #224 pulled up. This driver was what I was use to when obtaining cabs here in Milwaukee. He was polite, courteous and as he heard me on the phone with dispatch complaining he slipped me a small slip of paper entitled "NOTICE TO PASSENGERS". While I was so upset and tired from a long day I did not get his name but I would like to commend him for a job well done. Please feel free to contact for more information if needed as I do not feel these 2 cab drivers are a positive role model for all taxi drivers here in Milwaukee. While I have never arrived on the last train before I have never had service quite like this but I do hope that it is investigated. Attached is pictures of both cabs involved.

To Whom It May Concern:

This is a complaint against MKE Cab license # 140.

My husband and I rode from the MKE airport to our home at ... I can't say specifically what time we got into the cab, but we were driven directly home, and I had to call 911 at 9:25pm, so I would say we started the ride at approx 9:00pm.

As we entered the cab my husband specifically asked the driver, "you take credit cards, right?", and the driver replied, "oh, yes, yes!". All is well and good until we arrived at our destination. We handed the driver our card as there was NO terminal installed in the cab. He took our card, then reached over to the passenger side of the cab and exclaimed, "OH NO! I left my phone at home, it has the thing, I don't have a way of taking the credit card!". (what cab driver leaves his phone at home!?)

We reminded the driver that we specifically asked, about accepting credit card payment, and he specifically said he did. Then he said, "wait, wait, I'll see if I can do it another way". Then proceeded to fumble around with a huge pile of papers on the passenger side floor, as if looking for a paper/swipe set-up. Naturally he was not able to produce that either. I said, "why don't you call your dispatcher and I can give them the card # and they can process it over the phone". That's when he said, "what dispatcher, it's just me." I went to grab the credit card back from him and he refused to let go, yelling "hey, hey, hey!!!". I told him if he didn't give us the card back that I would

call the police. He said, "fine - call them, go ahead, call them". That's when I dialed 911. In the mean time, my husband offered him \$20 to let us out of the cab and give us our bag back. He refused saying he can write down the card number and run the card "later".

I got a 911 operator on the line and described our problem with the cab driver to her as quickly as possible - she could barely hear me (and visa versa) as the driver was screaming so loudly at that point. I was actually beginning to fear for our safety. I told her that we had agreed on a credit card transaction and that basically we were now being held against our will, by a cab driver that was holding our credit card against our will! I think once the cabbie realized that I actually was on the phone with the police, he agreed to take the \$20 and get rid of us, so he could get out of there before the police actually arrived.

The only identification in the entire cab that I could find was the cab # 140 (a silver mini-van with red lettering). I never asked him his name, nor would he have given it to me I'm certain. I could identify him in a photo though. There certainly was no "Non-cash Payment Passenger Usage Guide" posted anywhere in the cab or I wouldn't have needed to hunt and peck online to find it buried here on the City of Milwaukee website!

I've never even come close to filing a complaint like this before, but I've heard cabbie horror stories from others (especially women traveling alone). Enough is enough. What if we had been out of town visitors? What sort of impression would that have been? I'm embarrassed just thinking about it.

Please follow-up with me so that I know this complaint has been heard, and what, if anything will be done in handling it.

I took cab number 297 from Northwestern Mutual Building to the Milwaukee Amtrak station at 5:15pm on 5/15. The driver loaded my luggage into the trunk, then proceeded to start the trip. He realized that the trunk was not properly closed, and proceeded to exit the vehicle and slam the trunk, forcing it shut, without first checking to see if anything was preventing it from closing. This resulted in severe damage to the leather handle of my bag (see photo below) which he had placed in the trunk in a manner that caused it to be caught when the door closed. The bag manufacturer does not provide repair services, so I would like to request that Yellow Cab Milwaukee cover the cost of repair as this situation could have been avoided had the driver first checked to see if anything was in the way before slamming the trunk. For the record, I would like to say that other than this incident, the driver was very polite and apologetic once I brought the situation to his attention, which I very much appreciate.

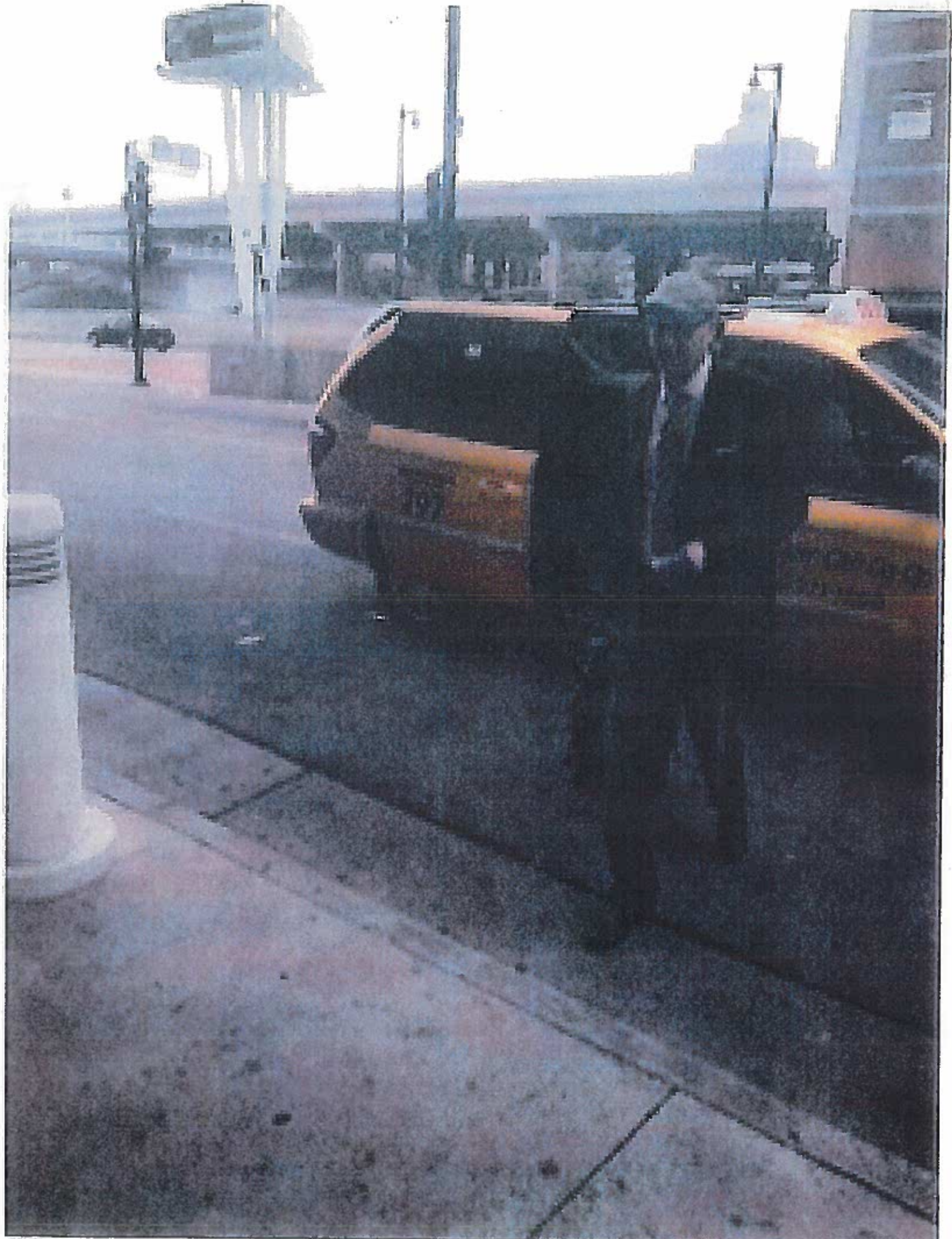

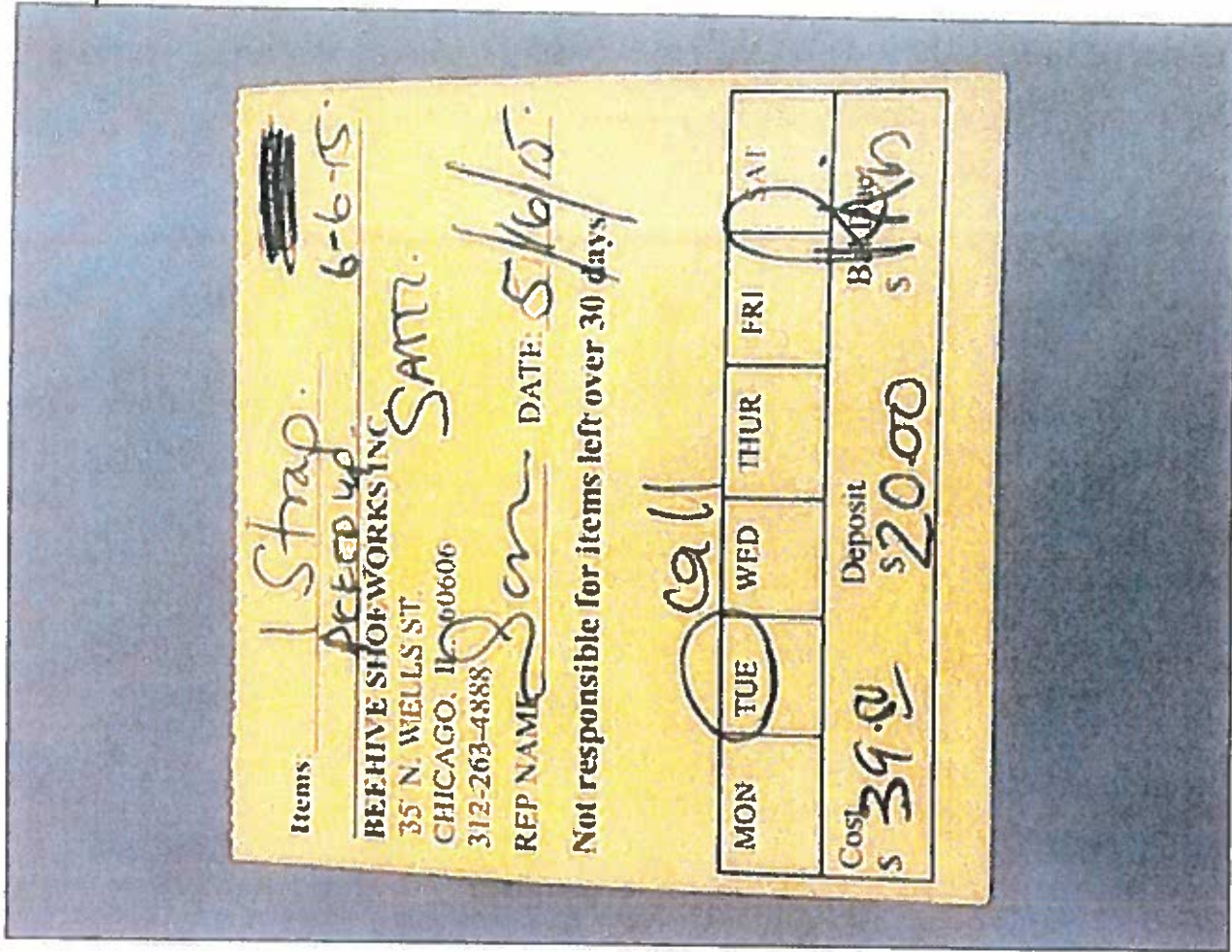

I took cab number 297 from Northwestern Mutual Building to the Milwaukee Amtrak station at 5:15pm on 5/15. The driver loaded my luggage into the trunk, then proceeded to start the trip. He realized that the trunk was not properly closed, and proceeded to exit the vehicle and slam the trunk, forcing it shut, without first checking to see if anything was preventing it from closing. This resulted in severe damage to the leather handle of my bag (see photo below) which he had placed in the trunk in a manner that caused it to be caught when the door closed. The bag manufacturer does not provide repair services, so I would like to request that Yellow Cab Milwaukee cover the cost of repair as this situation could have been avoided had the driver first checked to see if anything was in the way before slamming the trunk.

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For the record, I would like to say that other than this incident, the driver was very polite and apologetic once I brought the situation to his attention, which I very much appreciate.

Dear Ms. Moonsiefert:

My name is nan. I am a cs practice at in the firm's New York office.

On February 29, 2016, I arrived at General Mitchell International Airport from LaGuardia at about 5:10 PM, which was a little bit earlier than the schedule time of arrival set at 5:27 PM (see file attached "Itinerary.pdf").

At about 5:30 PM, I took a metered taxicab from General Mitchell International Airport to the Milwaukee Marriott Downtown Hotel, located at 323 East Wisconsin Ave, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202. The taxicab pertained to the Yellow Cab Cooperative and the driver's name was Mohamed Warsame.

I arrived at the hotel at about 5:45 PM and paid the metered fare with my American Express credit card. I checked in at the hotel at 17:49 (i.e. 5:49 PM) as shown on the Marriot's guest folio (see file attached "Hotel folio-Milwaukee.pdf"). The trip from the airport to the hotel takes about 15 to 20 minutes and it is at most 10.3 miles (see file "Map from General+Mitchell+International to Marriot Hotel.pdf").

As I pointed out above, when Mr. Warsame dropped me off at the hotel, I paid the metered fare of about \$35 (which included a \$5 tip) with my American Express credit card. At that time, he requested my credit card and swiped it using a mobile device named Square. In doing so, Mr. Warsame violated Section 100-51.5-3 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances (see file "Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.pdf," item 4 on page 3).

Further, Mr. Warsame refused to give me a metered receipt printed out from the taximeter. Instead, he gave an empty receipt card, which I filled out at the hotel (see file "taxi receipt from Milwaukee airport to hotel - 022916.pdf). Mr. Warsame's refusal to provide me with an itemized receipt constitutes also a violation of Section 100-51.5-3 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances (see file "Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.pdf," item 5 on page 3).

A few days after, while preparing my expense report, I saw on my credit card statement a charge for \$350.05 on 2/29/2016 from Milwaukee Taxicab (see file "AMEX Statement_Mar 2016.pdf"). Please note that the AMEX statement attached also shows that Mr. Warsame used the mobile device "Square" to swipe my card rather than credit card processing equipment that according to Milwaukee ordinances should be installed in the rear seat of the taxicab.

I have no idea how Mr. Warsame was able to charge my credit card \$350.05, when I recall that I signed my name on the Square mobile device, which showed a charge of \$35.05. I do remember that Mr. Warsame asked for my credit card twice, because he told me that the first time he could not manage to process the charge through Square.

In order to further demonstrate that the taxi fare from General Mitchell International Airport to the Milwaukee Marriott Downtown Hotel should not have been more than \$35.00, I have attached a taximeter receipt for \$29.00 (\$33 including a \$4.00 tip) that is dated 3/21/2016, which corresponds to a second trip to Milwaukee that I made during the month of March (see file "taxi receipt from Milwaukee Airport to Hotel-032116.pdf).

Therefore, I request that the License Division of City Clerk's Office take appropriate measures against Mr. Mohamed Warsame for violating the respective sections of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and for the fraudulent charge of \$350.05 to my credit card.

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
