There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

ORDER TO IMMEDIATELY CEASE ALL FOOD OPERATIONS

August 14, 2019

EL INFERNO, LLC 2000 W MITCHELL ST MILWAUKEE WI 53204

Dear Entrepreneur:

It has recently come to the attention of the City of Milwaukee Health Department that you are operating a food business which is required to be regulated by Federal, State and local laws. A valid City of Milwaukee Food Dealer's license is required in order to sell, store or distribute food per the City of Milwaukee Ordinance 68-21(a).

The City of Milwaukee has adopted the Wisconsin Food Code (DHS 196/ ATCP 75) and all of the codes within. Currently under the law in Wisconsin, with the exception of food items included under the Cottage Food Law*, home based food business are not allowed nor are they licensable (DHS 196: code 3-201.11(b)). As the local authority responsible for enforcing the Wisconsin Food Code we are writing to inform you that your home based food business is not included under the Cottage Food Law and therefore is in violation of the City of Milwaukee Ordinance 68-21(a) and subject to citation.

All home based food operations must stop immediately. If you wish to operate a licensable food business in Wisconsin, you have several options available to you. These options include renting commercial kitchen space from an existing licensed operator or securing your own commercial kitchen. We welcome you to contact Consumer Environmental Health at 414-286-3674 to discuss your future business plans.



The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 10/22/2019 at 9:30 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing to object to the application submitted by Harvender Singh, Agt. Terry SRA LLC, for a Class A Fermented Malt Beverage Retailer's and Food Dealer Retail-Convenience Store license at 3100 W. Mitchell Street.

I am the Shelter Manager for the Milwaukee Women's Center, a division of Community Advocates. The Milwaukee Women's Center's Emergency Shelter is located across the street from this store. The store is also in close proximity to young people who attend Carmen High School of Science and Technology and ALBA Elementary School (1712 S. 32nd St.).

Our 65-bed, 24/7 emergency shelter provides a safe refuge for adults and children fleeing domestic violence or surviving homelessness. Many of the adult guests in the shelter are also in recovery for drug or alcohol abuse, and the adults and children have survived trauma.

I believe that allowing liquor to be sold at this store puts the emergency shelter guests at great risk. At a time when they should be focusing on their health, wellbeing, safety and stability, providing easy access to liquor could derail their best efforts and jeopardize their sobriety and health. The city puts a great emphasis on helping survivors of domestic violence and homelessness, and granting this liquor license is contrary to that support.

I am asking you to deny this liquor license application so that we can enjoy a safe, healthy neighborhood and support the adults and kids in our shelter who are rebuilding their lives after trauma.

I would be happy to discuss this further with you.





recommendation to the Common Council. The Common Council must grant the license before it may be issued.
I understand proof of payment for all license fees must be on file in the License Division before the license may be
issued and the license must be issued and posted in my establishment prior to opening for business. I will not operate my food business until the license has been issued and posted in the establishment.
