The following is further information about the program that exists in Wauwatosa for neighborhood watch signs.

Wauwatosa has a Neighborhood Watch Steering Committee which meets monthly. There are several representatives of the Police Department on the committee as well as people who live and/or work in Wauwatosa. One of the members, a Police Captain, is the person who initiated the neighborhood watch sign program. Originally, the cost of the signs was split between the watch groups and the Police Department. Now the Police Department pays the full cost for the signs. A watch group makes the request for a neighborhood watch sign. To have a neighborhood watch sign erected requires that the majority of the block has watch signs in the windows of their homes. Unless an area is already saturated with neighborhood watch signs, requests are always granted.







This resolution amends a special privilege to Pipito Inc for removal of a popcorn wagon from the public right-of-way and for addition of six moveable planters in the public right-of-way for the premises at 7718-20 West Burleigh Street. Body

Whereas, Pipito Inc d/b/a Mama Mia Restaurant requested permission to keep and maintain a popcorn wagon, two covered walks, and four moveable planters in the public right-of-way; and

Whereas, Permission for said items was granted in 1992 under Common Council Resolution File Number 921064; and

Whereas, The applicant has removed the popcorn wagon from the public right-of-way; and

Whereas, A site visit revealed the presence of six additional moveable planters in the public right-of-way; and

Whereas, To eliminate property owner's liability for said popcorn wagon and to grant permission for the six additional moveable planters, the Common Council needs to adopt an amending resolution; now, therefore, be it

Resolved, By the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee that Common Council Resolution File Number 921064 is hereby rescinded; and, be it

Further Resolved, That Pipito Inc, 7718 West Burleigh Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53222, is hereby granted the following special privileges:

- 1. To keep and maintain ten, 4-foot diameter concrete moveable planters in the north, 12-foot wide sidewalk area of West Burleigh Street. Said planters are centered approximately 9 feet south of the northline of West Burleigh Street and are evenly spaced between the westline of North 77th Street and a point approximately 200 feet to the west.
- 2. To keep and maintain two covered walks projecting 10 feet into the north, 12-foot wide sidewalk area of West Burleigh Street. The east covered walk is 6 feet 6 inches wide and centered approximately 81 feet west of the westline of North 77th Street. The west covered walk is 9 feet wide and centered approximately 160 feet west of the westline of North 77th Street.

Said covered walks shall generally be constructed in accordance with the policies set forth in Common Council Resolution File Number 62-1211-a, adopted July 24, 1962. The covered walk frame shall be designed and supported to withstand snow and other loads of not less than 25 pounds per square foot applied in any direction. No guy wire brackets or diagonal braces shall be permitted lower than 8 feet above the sidewalk level. The coverings shall be of approved material. All fixtures and materials for illumination of the covered walks shall be indicated on the construction plans and approved prior to installation. No sign or advertising device shall be hung from, attached to, printed or painted on any part of the covered walks. The name, street number, or character of the business may be indicated only on the vertical portion of the covering and shall not exceed 8 inches in height.

The applicant is not required to maintain a "Loading Zone" or other "No Parking" adjacent to either covered walk.

Said above-mentioned items shall be used, kept and maintained to the satisfaction of the Commissioners of Public Works and Department of Neighborhood Services.

Said items shall be maintained or removed from the public right-of-way, at such future time as they are no longer needed, to the satisfaction of the Commissioners of Public Works and Department of Neighborhood Services.

; and, be it

Further Resolved, That this special privilege is granted only on condition that by acceptance of this special privilege the grantee, Pipito Inc, shall:

- 1. Become primarily liable for damages to persons or property by reason of the granting of this special privilege.
- 2. File with the City Clerk a certificate of insurance indicating applicant holds a public liability policy in the sum of at least \$25,000 covering bodily injury to any one person and \$50,000 covering bodily injury to more than one person in any one accident and \$10,000 covering property damage to any own owner on the area or areas included within the special privilege and naming the City of Milwaukee as an insured. Both bond and insurance policy shall provide that they shall not be cancelled until after at least thirty days' notice in writing to the City Clerk.
- 3. Pay to the City Treasurer an annual fee, which has an initial amount of \$300.00. The subsequent annual fee is subject to change pursuant to the annual fee schedule in effect at the time of annual billing.
- 4. Whenever this special privilege is discontinued for any reason whatsoever, including public necessity whenever so ordered by resolution adopted by the Common Council not only remove all construction work executed pursuant to this special privilege, but shall also restore to its former condition and to the approval of the Commissioner of Public Works and curb, pavement or other public improvement which was removed, changed or disturbed by reason of the granting of this special privilege. Such grantee shall be entitled to no damages due to the alteration and/or removal for such purposes.
- 5. Waive the right to contest in any manner the validity of Section 66.0425 of the Wisconsin Statutes (1999), or the amount of the annual fixed fee, payable on or before July 1st of each year.
- 6. Put this special privilege into use within one year after approval by the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee; failing to do so in the time specified, the Commissioner of Neighborhood Services shall have the authority to seek, by resolution, revocation of said special privilege.







EASEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, Made by and between the CITY OF MILWAUKEE, a municipal corporation of the State of Wisconsin, hereinafter referred to as "CITY", and LOCUST MILWAUKEE LLC, owner, (including heirs, personal representatives, successors or assigns, of above owner(s), as may be or may become applicable), hereinafter called "GRANTOR".

WITNESSETH

That, **WHEREAS**, the CITY desires to acquire a permanent underground EASEMENT, indicated as SE-2817 attached Exhibit "A", File Number 198-6-79, with the right of entry in and across the property hereinafter described and with the right to construct, operate, maintain, inspect, repair, enlarge, reconstruct and relocate, as may be or may become applicable, the following facilities and appurtenances thereto, in said property, namely a 21-inch diameter combined sewer, hereinafter called "FACILITIES."

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the grant of the EASEMENT for aforementioned FACILITIES hereinafter described and the payment of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable considerations to the GRANTOR, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said GRANTOR, being the owner interested in the land hereinafter described, does hereby grant unto the CITY a permanent EASEMENT for aforementioned FACILITIES with the right of entry in and across the property hereinafter described and with the right to construct, operate, maintain, inspect, repair, enlarge, reconstruct and relocate, as may be or may become applicable, the FACILITIES in and across the following described property in that part of the Northeast ¼ of Section 16, Township 7 North, Range 22 East, in the City of Milwaukee, County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the west line of the east ½ of vacated North Gordon Place and the north line of vacated East Locust Street;

Thence Easterly 15 feet along said north line to its point of intersection with the east line of vacated North Gordon Place;

Thence Southerly to a point lying 42 feet South of, as measured normal to, said north line;

Thence Westerly, parallel to said north line extended, 15 feet to a point in the southerly extension of the west line of the East ½ of North Gordon Place;


Thence Northerly, along said southerly extension, 42 feet to the point of beginning.

The above described permanent EASEMENT is a part of Tax Key Number 315-9986-110.

UPON CONDITION:

- 1. That said FACILITIES shall be maintained and kept in good order and condition by the City.
- 2. That no structures may be constructed within the limits of the EASEMENT by the Grantor excepting improvements such as lawns, concrete walks, roadways, driveways and parking lot surfacing. The City will replace such damaged or removed lawns, concrete walks, roadways, driveways and parking lot surfacing, at its own cost, after making any necessary repairs, reconstruction, or enlargement of the FACILITIES in the EASEMENT.
- 3. That in and during whatever construction, operation, maintenance, inspection, repair, enlargement, reconstruction or relocation is or becomes necessary with respect to said FACILITIES, so much of the surface or subsurface of the property as may be disturbed will, at the expense of the City, be replaced in substantially the same condition as it was prior to such disturbance: except that the City will in no case be responsible for replacing or paying for replacing any improvements other than lawns, concrete walks, roadways, driveways, or parking lot surfacing which were required to be removed in the course of doing the above work. However, the City shall save the Grantor harmless from any loss, damage, injury or liability resulting from negligence on the part of the City, its employees, agents and contractors, or its failure to comply with all local, state and federal environmental laws in connection with said work with respect to said FACILITIES or the City's use of the FACILITIES; provided, however, that if above loss, damage, injury or liability results from the joint negligence of the parties hereto, then the liability therefore shall be borne by them in proportion to their respective degree of negligence; provided further, however, that these provisions are subject to the legal defenses which, under law, the City is entitled to raise.
- 4. That, in connection with the construction by the Grantor of any structure or building adjacent to said EASEMENT, the Grantor will assume all liability for any damage to the FACILITIES in the above described property. The Grantor will also save and keep the City clear and harmless from any claims for personal injuries or property damage caused by any negligence of the Grantor or person other than the City, arising out of the construction by the Grantor of any structure or building adjacent to said EASEMENT, and shall reimburse the City for the full amount of such loss or damage.
- 5. That no additional charges will be made against said lands or Grantor for the cost of construction, operation, maintenance, inspection, repair, enlargement, reconstruction or relocation of said FACILITIES in the aforedescribed property. Excepting that 1) If the Grantor makes application for a permit to connect to said FACILITIES in the aforedescribed EASEMENT, the regular and customary connection permit fee in effect at the time of application shall be paid, and 2) The sewer maintenance, user fees or other sewer fees in effect for all City of Milwaukee serviced properties, that appear as charges to Grantor's herein described property, shall be paid.
- 6. That the FACILITIES shall be accessible for maintenance at all times. The Grantor shall submit plans for reasonable approval by the Commissioner of Public Works of the City for any underground installation within the EASEMENT.
- 7. That the Grantor shall submit plans for all surface grade alterations which would raise or lower the surface elevation by 1 foot or more within the limits of said EASEMENT. Said alterations shall be made only with the approval of the Commissioner of Public Works of the City, not to be unreasonably withheld.
- 8. That the Grantor shall be responsible for adjusting the elevations of all appurtenances necessitated by its alteration of surface elevations greater than one foot within the aforedescribed property. Said adjustments shall be required to provide free access to all sewer appurtenances and shall be made only with the approval of the Commissioner of Public Works of the City.
