NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

PLEASE NOTE: This hearing relates to the property within the boundary shown on the map on the reverse side of this notice. If your property is not within the zoning boundary, then you are receiving this notice because your property address is within 200 feet of the subject site.

PERSON OF INTEREST:

The City Plan Commission will hold a public hearing regarding a request to deviate from a performance standard established by the Riverwalk Site Plan Review Overlay Zone (SPROZ) that requires 24-hour-per-day public access to a new Riverwalk segment on the site located at 350 South Water Street, on the west side of the Milwaukee River, in the 12th Aldermanic District. The Riverwalk segment is required to be constructed in conjunction with the development of the site per the Riverwalk SPROZ, which was established in the late 1990's for the properties located along a portion of the Milwaukee River.

The owner of 350 South Water Street, Pontis, LLC, is proposing to construct a 5-story office building on the site, along with a Riverwalk segment that will be built along the river frontage on the east side of the lot. The design of the building within the SPROZ limits and the Riverwalk details must meet the applicable overlay standards. The Riverwalk SPROZ requires that the Riverwalk is open to the general public 24 hours a day at no charge, and the applicant is requesting relief from this overlay standard and not provide public access to this new Riverwalk segment until future Riverwalk segments either to the north or south of the site are constructed. Additionally, the new Riverwalk segment will not be constructed along the full length of the river frontage as required due to an encumbrance by the railroad bridge on the southeast 1/3 of the site. **Please refer to the reverse side of this notice for map details.**

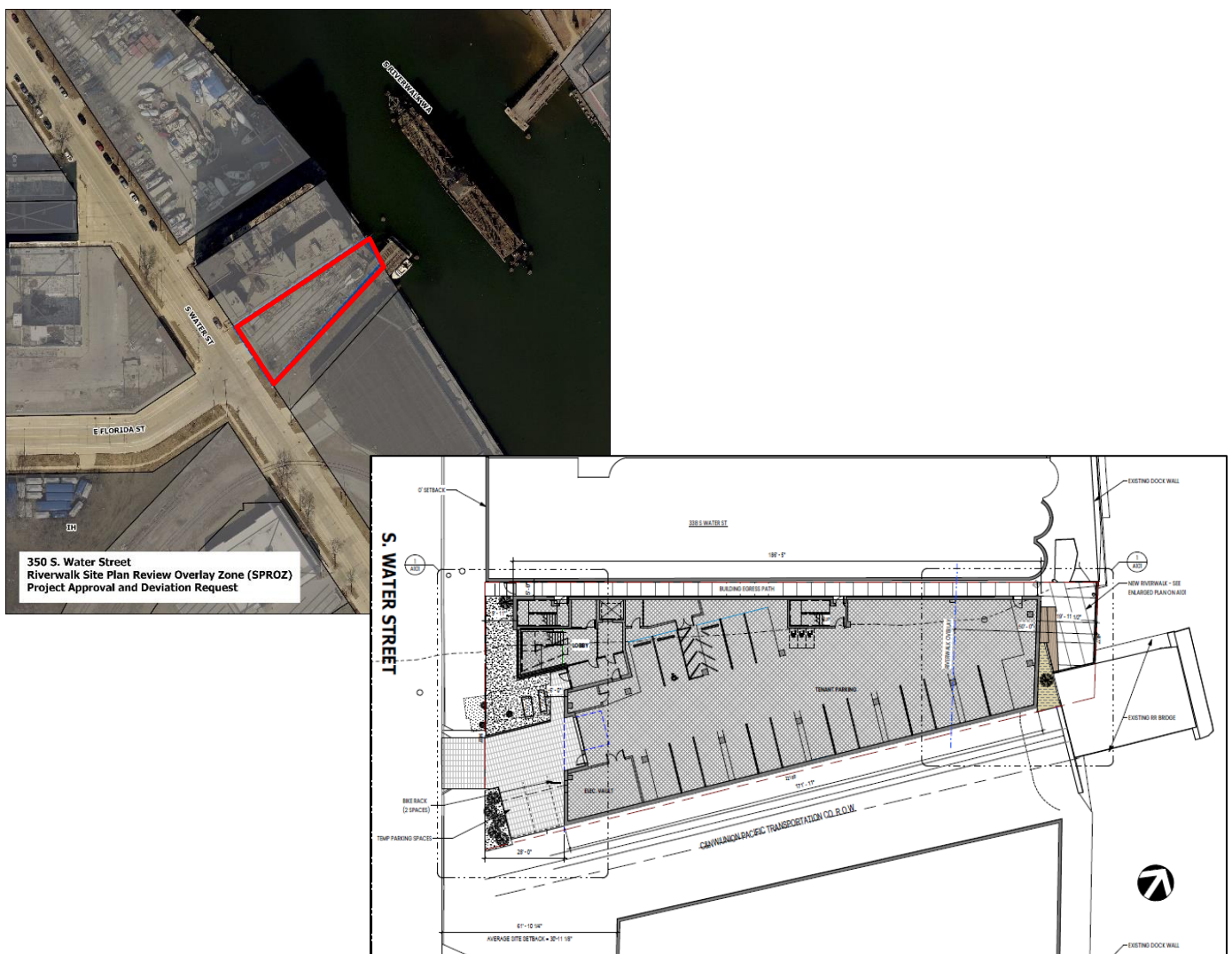
