Dear Alderdwoman Moore:

This is in response to a request from your office on behalf of a citizen to install the above-captioned parking restriction.

Our traffic engineering staff has investigated this request and found that south bound motorists exiting North 58th Street at West North Avenue have a difficult time seeing west bound traffic on West North Avenue when vehicles park close to the intersection. Therefore, in the interest of public safety, we recommend installing the above-captioned parking restriction to increase cross traffic visibility at the intersection.

We will prepare the necessary legislation for the next Public Safety and Health Committee meeting, so that you may support it to final passage.




