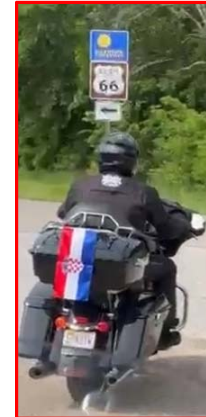

1. Honored with a MAYORAL PROCLAMATION, Monday May 8, 2023 IVAN MARCELIC Day, and Sister Cities COMMON COUNCIL RECOGNITION of the same. In spring 2023, the MAYOR of ZADAR, Croatia BRANKO DUKIC, sent a letter of support to Milwaukee MAYOR CAVALIER JOHNSON, in support of IVAN MARCELIC riding the famous Harley-Davidson Route 66 in May 2023.

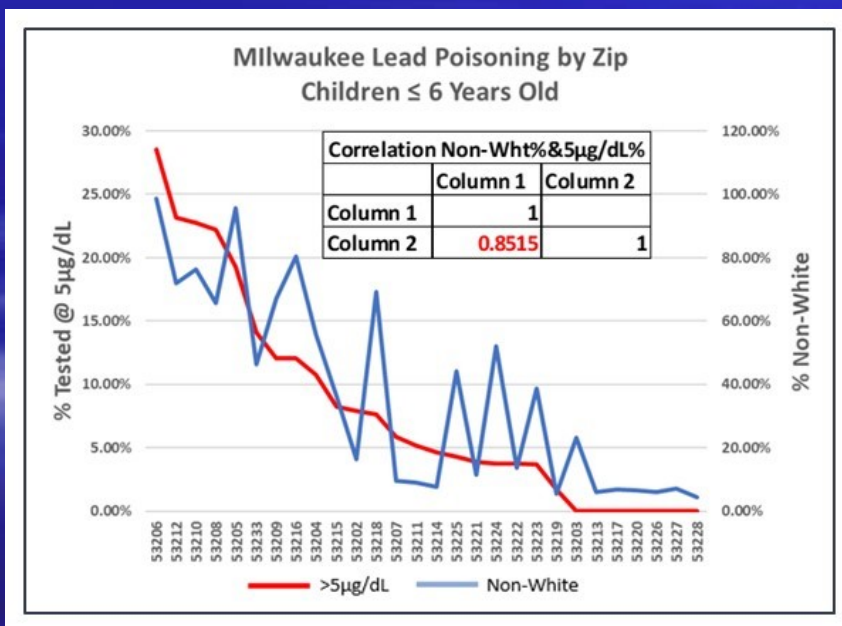

Slide 2. Sister Cities signing ceremony was held 8 years ago, with Mayor Tom Barrett signing on May 12, 2015 along with Common Council President, Michael J. Murphy, Ald. Joe Davis, Federation President John Braovac, coordinator Paul Lucas, and the Consulate General of the Republic of Croatia, Dr. Jelena Grcic-Polic, who proudly featured the common water centric heritage of the two cities – Zadar seated on the Adriatic Sea Coast and Milwaukee seated on the freshwater coast of Lake Michigan, with the vision of cultural exchange, economic cooperation, and diplomatic ties.

Slide 3. In 2018, MCT Milwaukee Croatian Tamburitzans YOUTH music and dance group visited with various public officials in Zadar. Building bridges through ARTS.

Slide 4. Locally building international bridges by staying engaged with the United Nations activities: WORLD FAIR April 11, 2019 at at the UWM Panther Arena, where MPS Elementary and Middle Schools researched and presented 193 poster presentations 193 countries. The Croatian Poster covered INTERESTING FACTS...HOLIDAYS...FOOD...LIFE AS A KID...LAND and CLIMATE...GAMES &

SPORTS. The project was sponsored by the United Nations Association of Greater Milwaukee; co-chairs Annette Robertson and Joan Robertson.

Slide 5. Building International bridges by participating in the Folk Fair. Between 2015 and 2018, at the height of Flint Michigan lead toxicity debate, our own Health Department provided data of unique reported cases of 5 ug/Dl and above in infants and children under 6 by zip code and ethnicity in Milwaukee. Of the children screened, 8.6% of the children in Milwaukee had elevated blood lead levels, compared with Flint with 5% of the children tested. Thus, our Outreach activities through SISTER CITIES were focused on water health. Apply the early learning through STEAM Science Technology Engineering Arts Math ...The idea connecting two cohort Elementary schools from both cities, run simple analytical tests, document, and digitally present to each other over the Atlantic. BILINGUALLY.
