There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkennes; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; thef; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffit, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. It is the intention of the Common Council to suspend or non-renew the license and/or police reports are found to be true by a preponderance of the evidence. The police reports and other attached documents relating to objections to the license are a part of this notice and expressly incorporated in this notice. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

This report is written by Police Officer Monreal, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

 On 05/28/2010 the applicant was cited in the City of Milwaukee at 1321 N. Edison St for Disorderly Conduct.

 - 2. On 01/25/2020 at 2:40am officers observed 3 subjects exit the north side door of White Tail, 1110 N. Old World Third St. The officers also observed a subject enter the bar through this door. The officers entered the business and observed people sitting at the bar with glasses of alcohol. The bartender stated he was unable to clear the bar at closing. The officers cleared the bar and advised this report would be filed.

- 3. On 02/13/21 at 12:15am, Milwaukee Police, along with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services, conducted a license premise check at 1110 N. MLK Drive. The follow violations were observed; no 6-foot spacing of patrons and no face coverings. The applicant was on scene and advised of the violations.
- 4. On 07/08/21 at 10:30pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1110 N. MLK Drive for a fight complaint. Investigation revealed that a patron was inside the establishment wanting to fight another patron who accidently bumped into him. When security tried to escort the patron out, he hit security and a fight broke out inside the tavern causing chairs and tables to be knocked over. The fight eventually headed outside into the street and police broke up the incident.
- 5. On 07/15/21 at 12:50am, A Milwaukee Police Officer was asked by a Milwaukee Police Sergeant to investigate a battery which occurred at 1110 N. MLK Drive. Investigation revealed that a patron was being disorderly inside the tavern and was asked to leave by security. After being escorted outside the establishment, the patron used a racial slur and spit on security. Security then shoved and punched the patron before closing the front door.
- 6. On 07/21/21 at 4:35pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a battery which occurred at 1110 N. MLK Drive. Investigation revealed that a patron left his debit card inside the tavern and security let him in to close out his bill. His female companion, who was not allowed inside, waited for her companion to leave, stepped in the open doorway, and began swinging at security. The male companion steppes between the female and security and the female falls to the ground clear of the tavern door.
- 7. On 01/01/22 at 3:47am., officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 1110 N. Old World Third. Investigation revealed two patrons were smoking marijuana in the tavern and asked to leave. The patrons became verbally and physically aggressive to staff and were escorted out of the establishment.

- 8. On 05/09/22 at 10:58pm., officers were dispatched to a Fight at 1110 N. Old World Third. On arrival officers observed security breaking up a fight inside the establishment and escorting the subjects out. Management was cooperative with the investigation.
- 9. On 07/18/22 at 1:19am., officers were in the area of 1100 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr., and monitoring bar close, when they observed 20-25 subjects fighting in front of 1110 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. A victim, who was bleeding from the nose, stated he was walking out of the bar and observed an argument outside, when he was struck by an unknown subject. The victim, who was highly intoxicated became uncooperative and refused medical or police service. Officers interviewed the manager, who stated he didn't know what happened and does have working security cameras, however, they would not have captured the incident in the area it occurred. Management was cooperative and security did make an attempt to break up the fight.

- 10. On 08/28/22 at 1:39am., officers assigned to Code Red, heard a loud bang in the area of 1100 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Investigation revealed two patrons began to argue inside the bar and were escorted out by security. Once outside, the argument escalated and the suspect, who admitted to being inside the tavern with his firearm, pulled his firearm out and fired one round into the ground. The suspect who was highly intoxicated, was arrested and his firearm and a single casing that was located outside of 1110 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr., in the parking lot, was placed on inventory. A victim, who was inside the tavern was treated for a gun shot wound to his leg at a local hospital. A witness was interviewed and stated they observed the two subjects fighting inside the tavern and attempted to escort them outside, when he observed the suspect pull the firearm out and point it at the neck of the second subject, then point it at the ground and fire a single round. The establishment had been notified in the past by Police, they should be checking patrons for weapons prior to allowing them in to the establishment.
- 11. On 04/13/24 at 1:36a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Fight at 1110 N. Martin Luther King. Investigation revealed three subjects were involved in a physical altercation inside the establishment. None of the subjects wanted to prosecute, however, a subject that identified themselves as an owner, continuously interfered with the investigation, grabbing one of the suspects by the arm and pulling them away from the officer during the interview. The "owner" was warned they were interfering but continued to interfere, stating "I am more connected then just an owner" and pushed the officer's arm away. The "owner" was not arrested or cited, however, the entire altercation was captured on the officer's body worn camera. The business was uncooperative.

LICENSED PREMISE REPORT

Gainer, Jeremie V 029193

This report was written by P.O. Jeremie GAINER, assigned to District One, Late Power shift.

On Friday April 12th, 2024, at approximately 7:00 PM, P.O. Andrew DUDLEY and I (squad 1430) were assigned to Martin Luther King Jr Street for Code Red deployment at District One. This is located in the City and County of Milwaukee. At approximately 1:36 AM on Saturday April 13th, I was flagged down by an unidentified citizen. A fight broke out between the two, starting inside the establishment of Whitetail MKE, a Tavern located at 1110 N Martin Luther King. The fight started inside, spilling out onto the street. I arrived on foot and observed approximately 3 females engaging in a physical fight. I separated the individuals I had the opportunity to interview Jazmin M RIVAS (W/F, 03-08-88). RIVAS was one of the subjects involved with the fight.

Interview with Jazmin RIVAS

RIVAS revealed that the person she was fighting with was someone who had dated her brother in the past. She mentioned that she had caught this individual treating her brother children poorly, which had caused tension between them. RIVAS expressed her dislike for this person due to the way she had treated her family during the time she was dating her brother.

During the altercation, RIVAS stated she was jumped by another girl who is currently dating the person she was fighting with. Despite the physical altercation, RIVAS made it clear that she did not wish to press charges at this time. Her main priority was to go home and put this unfortunate incident behind her.

RIVAS was issued an MPD contact card and was free to leave the scene.

Interview with Melissa Y GONZALEZ (w/f, 08-06-92)

GONZALEZ is a security guard for Whitetail. GONZALEZ was involved in the fight with RIVAS. An attempt was made to interview GONZALEZ, but she refused. GONZALEZ walked away with Whitetail owner SAMPSON.

Incident with Michael J SAMPSON (w/m, 08-03-83)

SAMPSON, who identified as the owner of whitetail was on scene and behaved poorly with officers. As the lead investigator, I was conducting an interview with a suspect when SAMPSON decided to interfere with the process.

During the interview, SAMPSON grabbed the suspect's arm and pulled her away from me. I immediately informed SAMPSON that he was interfering with an ongoing investigation, and he was not involved with. I explained to him that it is not acceptable to disrupt the interview process and that he must respect the legal boundaries of the situation.

Despite my warnings, SAMPSON persisted in his actions, pushing my arm away and pulling the suspect further away from me. I reiterated that his behavior was unacceptable and warned him

that he would be cited or arrested for obstruction if he continued. However, SAMPSON disregarded my lawful order and continued to interfere with the investigation. I explained to SAMPSON that this is not how the process works. SAMPSON stated, "This is how it works" and walked away with the suspect. SAMPSON also stated, "I am more connected that just an owner".

In a desperate attempt to assert his authority, SAMPSON began yelling for the sergeant who was occupied with another matter. He continued to pull the suspect along with him, completely disregarding my authority as an officer of the law.

This behavior was not only unacceptable but also illegal. The owner of Whitetail must understand that he is not above the law and that interfering with a police investigation is a serious offense. I urged the owner to cooperate with law enforcement and respect the boundaries of the investigation process.

SAMPSON was very uncooperative.

At this time SAMPSON was not arrested or cited.

This incident was captured by body worn camera.

The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 5/20/2025 at 9:40 AM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.

2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)

3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).

4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.

5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.) 6. You may then provide testimony.

a. Include only information relating to the above license application.

b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.

c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.

d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.

7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.

8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
