### DEAR PROPERTY OWNER:

The Common Council has referred to the City Plan Commission for recommendation on File No. 050826 being a substitute ordinance relating to the change in zoning from General Planned Development (GPD) to a Detailed Planned Development (DPD) known as Columbia St. Mary's Main Hospital Campus, on land located on the North Side of East North Avenue between North Prospect Avenue and North Lake Drive, in the 3rd Aldermanic District. This substitute ordinance approves the design of the main hospital campus and parking structure. The medical office buildings and patient rooms would be along West North Avenue, with the main entrance and drop off area along North Lake Drive. The parking structure would be to the rear with vehicular access off of North Prospect Avenue. A new publicly-accessible emergency department and public plaza area will occupy space on the southwest corner of the new main hospital at the ground level. **Please see the reverse side of this notice for map details.**


