Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery, acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

North Ave. The officers heard loud music and entered the tavern. they observed 20 patrons sitting at the bar with some continuing to consume alcohol. The applicant was the bartender. 3. On 05/06/2017 at 2:30am officers observed a large group of cars parked in front of TJ's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av. At 2:40am the officers conducted a tavern check. The officers heard loud music coming from inside. The security guard unlocked the door and told everyone they had to leave. The officers counted 40 patrons leaving the bar. The manager was Kevine BARNETT and he did not understand why officers made contact with the tavern. The applicant was cited for Class B Premises Allow Patron after Hours.

4. On 06/24/2017 officers were dispatched to TJ's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av, for a fight. Upon arrival the officers were advised by security that one subject left and the other was in the parking lot. The officers observed the intoxicated subject in the parking lot refusing to leave. He was detained when he attempted to strike one of his friends.

5. On 01/01/2018 officers were dispatched to an Entry complaint at 2911 W. North Av. The officer was met by a security company that had an open front door. The officer searched the building and found nothing out of the ordinary. The investigation determined the employee had left the door unlocked when they left for the day.

6. On 05/28/2018 officers were dispatched to a Shotspotter call at 2929 W. North Av. The officers went to 2911 W. North Av to check for witnesses. They spoke with the manager, Kevin BARNETT, who stated he did not hear any shots and would be closing the bar for the night.

The caller stated his 15-year-old sister was in the bar and there were subjects smoking marijuana. The officers checked the ID's of the patrons and did not find anyone underage. No violations observed.
- 9. On 06/28/2019 officers were dispatched to T-Jay's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av, for a property damage complaint. The officer interviewed the victim who stated she was inside T-Jav's from 1:30am to 1:50am. When she came out her car door window was broken and items missing. The victim was found to be 20-years-old. The officer interviewed the manager and the door man who stated they did not let anyone underage in the bar. The applicant was issued a citation for Allow Underage on Premise.

- 10. On 07/01/2019 at 1:09am officers were dispatched to a subject with gun in the area of T-Jay's, 2911 W. North Av. The officer spoke with the caller by phone, who stated a security guard had brandished a firearm. The caller was uncooperative and hung up on the officer. The officer went to T-Jay's and spoke with the manager, Kevine BARNETT. He stated nothing out of the ordinary happened that night. The staff was very cooperative with the officers.
- 11. On 08/25/2019 at 2:20am officers were dispatched to N. 29<sup>th</sup> St and W. North Av for a shotspotter call of over 30 rounds fired. The officer interviewed the manager of T-Jay's, 2911 W. North Av. He stated they had no problems that night and were closing at 2:15am when they heard shots fired from a vehicle on the street. He provided video which showed a vehicle exit the parking lot to the west of T-Jay's and pull up to another vehicle on the street. One vehicle fired at another and both fled. One of the vehicles fleeing struck a parked car, flipping it on its side.
- 12.On 09/03/2019 at 1:08am officers were dispatched to T-Jay's lounge for a wanted subject. The subject was located and arrested without incident.
- 13. On 09/08/2019 at 1:17am officers conducted a licensed premise check at T-Jay's Lounge, 2911 W. North Av. The officer observed more than 80 cars in the area and conducted a capacity check. The door man stated he thought capacity was 136 and they had about 120-130 patrons. The officer checked and found capacity was 80 people. The bar was closed and all subjects were counted as they exited and the officer counted 213 people, which included employees. The investigation also revealed the bar was charging a cover charge, which wasn't posted and was serving food without a license. The manager stated they did not need a food dealer license because they were giving the food away. The applicant was cited for the violations.
- 14. On 09/22/2019 at 1:18am officers were dispatched to T-Jay's Lounge for a tavern violation. The caller stated there were several underage people inside the bar. The door man stated he knew the officers would be coming because he had turned away female with no ID. The officers checked the bar and did not locate anyone underage.
- 15. On 10/04/2019 a meeting was held at District 3 regarding T Jay's Lounge. The applicant stated she is not involved in the daily business, her husband Kevine BARNETT, runs the business. She stated she was unaware of several of the incidents at the business. She was advised of the recent incident on 09/08/2019 and the possible citations. She was advised to use a counter, post signs with prices and monitor patrons at close. She stated she would advise BARNETT of the information provided.

On Friday, June 21, 2019 at 1:35AM, Squad 3465, myself and PO Devin WHITFIELD, were dispatched to a Tavern Violation at 2911 W North Ave, T-jay's Lounge, located in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

Squad 3490, PO Jeremie GAINER, Squad 3390, PO Justin YOUNG and PO Lamar DENTON, and Squad 3310, Sergeant Bobby CASHAW, also responded to this call.

The caller notified MPD dispatch that his 15 year old sister was inside the bar and that people were inside smoking weed.

Upon our arrival, squads were already on scene and cleared out the crowd. Officers went inside of the establishment and asked everyone for ID's to ensure they were of legal drinking age. There were two females, who were of legal drinking age. There were approximately five other individuals inside who were employees. PO WHITFIELD and myself spoke with the manager on scene, Kevine J BARNETT (b/m 05-26-83) who stated he was the manager of the establishment. BARNETT stated no people were inside that were under age. BARNETT stated that a group of subjects were escorted out of the establishment earlier in the night and that they could have been upset and called in the complaint. Officers found no other people, and nothing suspicious or out of the ordinary appeared to be occurring inside of the establishment.

On Friday, June 28, 2019 at 1:48 AM, PO Natalie CRUZ and I (squad 3465) responded to T Jay's Lounge located at 2911 W North Ave in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin for a Property Damage complaint. Upon arrival, Linterviewed Tanaja A WEBB (b/f, 01-15-99) and Darlene COLLINS (b/f, 03-23-99) who stated that their vehicle was broken into and property was removed from their vehicle while they were inside of T Jay's Lounge.

## Interview of Tanaja A WEBB (b/f, 01-15-99) and Darlene COLLINS (b/f, 03-23-99)

I interviewed WEBB and COLLINS outside of T Jay's Lounge in the parking lot. WEBB and COLLINS stated that they parked their vehicle inside T Jay's Lounge parking lot at 1:30 AM. WEBB and COLLINS stated that they returned to the vehicle at 1:50 AM and saw the front driver's side window broken and COLLINS' purse to be missing. WEBB and COLLINS did not want to have a report filed regarding the damaged window and the stolen property.

WEBB and COLLINS identified themselves verbally and stated that they did not have their identification cards with them. WEBB and COLLINS both admitted to being inside of T Jay's Lounge from 1:30 AM to 1:50 AM on 06-28-2019. WEBB and COLLINS are both 20 years old and were inside of T Jay's Lounge. This is a violation of City of Milwaukee Ordinance 90-19-1 which states that "no underaged person, not

accompanied by his or her parent, guardian, or spouse who has attained the legal drinking age, may enter, knowingly attempt to enter, or be on any premises for which a license or permit for the retail sale of alcohol beverages has been issued."

#### Interview of Kevine J BARNETT (b/m, 05-26-83)

I interviewed Kevine J BARNETT (b/m, 05-26-83) inside of T Jay's Lounge. BARNETT stated that he is the bartender at T Jay's Lounge and stated that no one underage or without an identification card was let inside of the bar.

BARNETT contacted the security guard by phone who was working and checking identification cards at the door on 06-28-19. The security guard was identified as Wesley T WALKER (b/m, 01-03-81). WALKER stated that he checked all identification cards on 06-28-19 and stated that no one underage or without an identification card was let inside of the bar.

#### Issuance of Citaitons

T Jay's Lounge was issued a citation for Presence of Underage Persons in Places of Sale (citation #J9806WD6PQ). WEBB was issued a citation for Presence of Minor at Licensed Premises (citation #J9806WD6PR). COLLINS was also issued a citation for Presence of Minor at Licensed Premises (citation #J9806WD6PS).

#### **Licensee Notification**

I contacted the Agent for T Jay's Lounge, Shanita M COTTON (b/f, 02-06-88), by phone on 06-29-19 at 5:29 AM. I informed COTTON of this incident and informed her that T Jay's Lounge, as well as WEBB and COLLINS, would be issued citations. COTTON stated that she has very good security guards at her establishment and stated that they would not have allowed anyone underage or without an identification card into the establishment.

On Monday, July 1st, 2019 at approximately 1:09am, squads were called to the area for a subject with a gun. Upon arrival I spoke to the alleged victim who was extremely uncooperative and verbally abusive even after I identified myself as a police officer. Only information given was that a security guard brandished a firearm at the victim. No description was given for the guard that allegedly committed this act. Victim refused to provide personal information and hung up.

Follow up was conducted at T'Jay's Lounge and patrons informed us that fireworks were set off just down the block and that there didn't appear to be any incidents inside or outside the bar.

I attempted to contact the listed agent, Shanita M. COTTON, (B/F,02/06/1988), at 1:45am, received no answer.

I spoke with the on duty manager, Kevin J. BARNETT, (B/M, 05/26/1983) who stated that nothing out of the ordinary had happened tonight.

It should be noted that all members of T'Jay's Lounge were very cooperative.

2:19:16 Shotspotter detected 3 rounds at 2451 W North Ave.

Upon arriving on scene I observed a vehicle on it side just south of W North Ave on N 29th St with a large group of people surrounding it and a subject on the ground.

I spoke to the bartender that was on scene, Kevine J BARNETT (M/B 5/26/83) who stated that they did not have any problems during the night and were pushing everyone out of the bar at approximately 2:15 AM when gun shots were heard. BARNETT stated that they gunshots were from vehicles passing by on the street. BARNETT showed me video from the exterior which showed a brown or maroon smaller 4dr vehicle exit the parking lot to the west of T Jay's Lounge and slowly drive beside a vehicle that was stopped in the interior lane of eastbound traffic when I could observe muzzle flashes from the driver's side door of the vehicle and it fled out of view. BARNETT stated that he would attempt to e-mail me a copy of that night's video.

36 casings were recovered in the street on W North Ave started just west of 2911 W North Ave and going east to N 28th St. Of the casings recovered 1 was .380, 19 were 9mm, 15 were .40 cal, and 1 was unidentified. No vehicles or buildings were located that were struck by the gunfire. The casings were placed on inventory at District 3 (AC 19028261). The accident was to be determined to have occurred by a vheicle fleeing the gunfire and striking a parked vehicle casing it to roll.

On Sunday, September 8th, 2019 at 12:30 AM, Squad 3465, P.O. Larry LEIBSLE and I, conducted a tavern check on T-Jay's Lounge at 2911 W North Ave. Upon arriving on scene I checked the number of vehicles in the area and observed more than 80 vehicles in and around the bar. The bar is located on W North Ave between N 29th St and W 30th St and there is no residential houses in the area on W North Ave. I notified Sgt KINGSTON regarding and we set up with squads to do a capacity check. Squad 3412 (Sgt KINGSTON) Squad 3440 (P.O. ALVAREZ and P.O. FEKETE) Squad 3430 (P.O. DOMBECK) Squad 3450 (P.O. GAINER) and Squad 3441 (P.O. WHITFIELD and P.O. ZUBE) responded to assist with the check.

Upon arriving on scene at 2911 W North Ave | spoke to the security guard that was on the door who identified himself as Wesley T WALKER (M/B 1/3/81). WALKER stated that he thought the capacity was 136 or so and figured that they had around 120-130. Prior to our arrival I had checked and knew T-Jay's Lounge's capacity was 80. We had WALKER turn the music off and have everyone exit the bar. P.O. WHITFIELD and P.O. ZUBE were positioned at the back of the building to make sure no one exited out the rear. Sgt KINGSTON, P.O. LEIBSLE and I were positioned at the front door with P.O. LEIBSLE keeping the flow of patrons slow and I counted the patrons as they exited out loud and with a hand held counting device. All this was recorded on our Axon Flex Body Camera. I counted 213 people that were inside the bar at the time of our arrival which includes bar staff.

As we initially approached the bar we observed two males attempt to enter the bar but were told the cover was 20 dollars and they exited the bar as we walked up without paying. While patrons were exiting the bar I heard several females complain that they had just got their and were out 10 dollars because of us and wanted it back. I also observed several people exiting with black Styrofoam containers which appeared to contain food. Upon doing a walk through of the bar to make sure all subjects were continued I observed two slow cookers at the rear of the bar which one of the staff stated had chicken curry and rice in it. I also observed two grills in the back patio area which were still hot and a black styrofoam container like the ones that patrons were exiting with, which contained the chicken curry over rice, was on the back patio bar.

I spoke to the Manager/Bartender Kevine J BARNETT who stated that his capacity was 80 and 46 for the patio. BARNETT also stated that there is a cover charged and I asked him if it was posted and he stated it

This meeting was scheduled due to recent citizen complaints, aldermanic concerns, and over capacity investigations.
