This is to notify you that on June 22, 2004 the City's Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your renewal application for a Class "B" Tavern, Tavern Dance and Billiard Hall license for the premises at 1921 West Mitchell Street in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin ("Club Presidente") not be approved.
