There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. 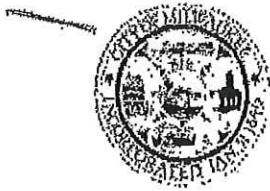

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:

The new licensee appears to be engaging in a collusive agreement with her father and uncle. When arriving to the location to do the CPTED, the licensee wasn't on scene and her father was answering all the questions. We then requested the actual licensee to arrive and she did.

When asking the licensee when she would be at the establishment, the licensee gave a general answer and stated from 1:00 PM until 9:00 PM on different days through-out the week. The licensee stated her father and her uncle would mainly be running the establishment because she is finishing school.

I informed the licensee of the concerns with drug dealing in the neighborhood, loitering at the establishment, and the constant disregard of patrons disobeying the parking ordinances in front of the location.

- Advised the business to clear out the windows from signage
- The store has "No loitering" signs, however to add another closer to the door.
- Possibly make the front of the store a loading zone which may help with illegal parking and allow the front entrance of the store to be visible at all times.

-block off the rear of the location where the dumpsters are so people can't walk freely through the parking lot.

2. On 11/13/10, Milwaukee police, along with members from the Wisconsin Wins Tobacco Initiative conducted sales of tobacco products to underage persons. A 15 year old entered 2438 W Hopkins and was able to purchase a package of Newport 100's without providing any ID. The cashier was identified as Daya Ahmad. The licensee Fathi Jaber was cited for this violation.

On 03/13/11 at 5:35 pm, Milwaukee police were conducting sales of alcohol to underage persons and had a police aide, who is under the age of 21, enter 1535 W North Avenue in attempts to purchase alcohol. The clerk sold the aide a 6 pack of Heineken beer in bottles even though the aide provided his ID. The clerk was identified as Nael Zaal who stated he thought he read the DOB as 1998. Zaal was cited as well as the licensee Fathi Jaber.

4. On 09/29/2013 a Milwaukee police officer made contact with the applicant at 1535 West North Avenue (Superior Food and Liquor). This officer advised the applicant regarding the requirements for a secondhand dealer license and provided him with a copy of Milwaukee City Ordinance 92 (secondhand dealer ordinance). The officer observed approximately 30 used devices (cell phones, tablet etc.) for sale, but the applicant would not tell the officer where these items came from.
5. On 01/24/2014 a Milwaukee police officer conducted a licensed premise check at 1535 West North Avenue (Superior Food and Liquor) to check for compliance with the requirements pertaining to their secondhand dealer's license. The officer initially met with resistance from employees who stated they did not buy cell phones, but traded old ones for new. The officer told the employee that taking used phones in trade must also be reported to police through NEWPRS. The officer indicated he would return at a later date to set up a NEWPRS account for the business.

6. On 04/11/2015 a shotspotter call came in for the location of 2327 North 16th street, shortly thereafter Mt. Sinai Hospital called for a subject with a gunshot wound to the chest for an incident that occurred at 16th Street and West North Avenue. The victim, Dealaneo Hodges, told officers he works for City Wide public security and that he is armed with a .40 caliber Glock during work. Hodges stated he closed the premise at 9:00pm and that as he was walking toward his truck he heard someone running towards him. Hodges looked back and observed a subject pointing a black revolver at him. Hodges was subsequently shot once in the chest and once in the back. Milwaukee police incident report #151010128 filed.

7. On 12/12/15, Officers were dispatched to an auto theft. The vehicle was left running in the parking lot of the establishment. When the owner of the vehicle exited the store, the vehicle was gone.

8. On 03/04/16, Officers observed a vehicle in the crosswalk in front of the establishment. The vehicle was revealed to be stolen. A subject exited the store and told officers he would move the vehicle. The subject, along with the front passenger of the vehicle was arrested.

9. On 07/25/16, Officers were dispatched to a battery at 15th Street and W North Ave. The victim stated the last thing he remembered was leaving 1535 W North Ave. Officers were able to view the video from the business. The victim was in front of the business speaking with the suspect. The suspect pushed the victim and then struck the victim to the face. The victim fell to the ground and lay motionless. The suspect and an unknown female fled the location.

10. On 11/08/2016 officers investigated a threat of force robbery that occurred outside of Super Foods and Liquor. The investigation revealed the suspect drove the victim to Super Foods. The victim entered the store, made a purchase and reentered the suspect's car where the robbery occurred.

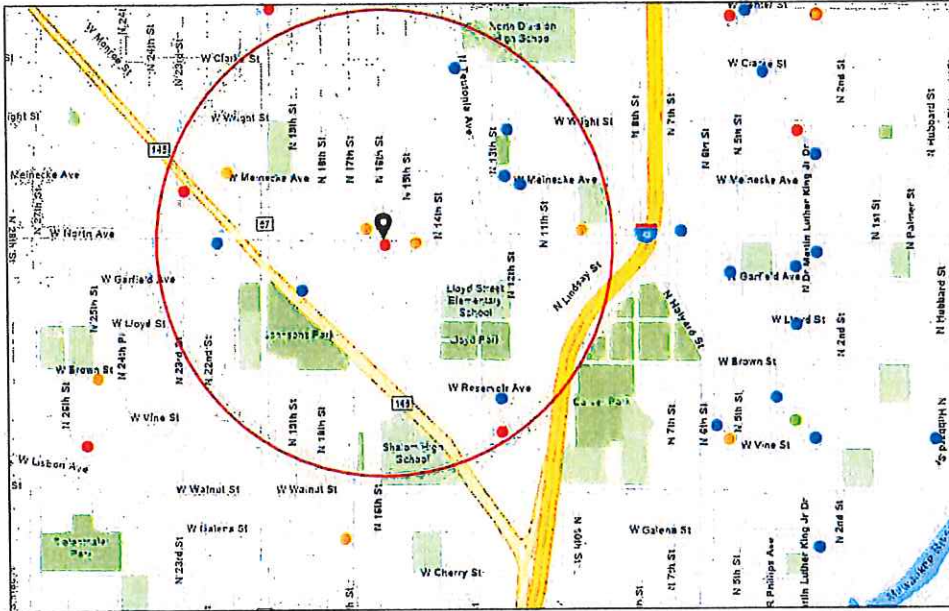
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11. On 07/18/2020 at 8:58pm officers investigated a shooting at N. 16th St and W. North Av. The investigation revealed the shooting happened outside of Superior Food and Liquor, 1535 W. North Av. The officer went to the store and spoke with the manager, who stated he heard the shots but did not see anything. The officers obtained the video from the store, which did capture the incident. The video showed the suspect running eastbound on North Avenue and shooting towards people. The victim was shot in the back. The victim stated there was a fight outside and one of the subjects fighting pulled a gun and began shooting.

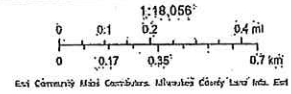




